pool records. He won the 50 freestyle in a pool-record 21.22, then swam a leg for the pool-record 200 freestyle relay team (1:26.33). Whitbeck also swam a leg for GCC's winning 200 medley relay team (1:40.83).

Both Bison teams posted good efforts against W&J and Saint Vincent last week, but still came up on the short end of the scoreboard ... Against

the Presidents, senior Stephen Zinz won a pair of events, touching first in the 100 butterfly by just .09 seconds in front of W&J's Eddie Werner with a time of 55.37 and winning the 500 freestyle in 5:31.75 ... For the women, freshman Desiree Finley won the one-meter event and junior Erin Staniech finished second in the 100 backstroke with her best of the year (1:07.95) ... Staniech had another good meet against Saint Vincent, posting two firsts ... She won the 200 freestyle (2:10.96), the 50 freestyle (26.92) and also grabbed second in the 200 backstroke (2:40.59) ... On the men's side, Zinz earned first place in the 100 butterfly (55.22).

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's men's team earned its 10th victory of the 2006-07 season Saturday with a win at W&J ... Freshmen **Rich Albertson** and **Chip Cressman**

each posted two wins ... Albertson won the 500 and 1000 while Cressman took the 200 back and 400 IM ... Sophomore Tim Whitbeck set a new W&J pool record in the 50 (21.22) ... Whitbeck, Peter Larsen, Caleb Courage and Drew Snyder set a new pool record in the 200 free relay (1:26.33) ... Lincoln Larsen won the 200 breaststroke while Mark Barron won the 200 free Kyle Grubbs won 1-meter diving ... This is Grove City's first double-digit win season since the 1996-97 team went 10-2 ... The Wolverines have won nine straight dual meets, Grove City's longest streak since winning 40 straight from 1993-96 ... Grove City's women fell to 1-1 in the PAC ... Freshman Jane Wilson won both the 50 and 100 free races for GCC ... Junior Ellen Keefer posted a pair of runner-up finishes (100 free, 200 free) ... Tuesday, Grove City hosts Westminster ... On the men's side, Westminster owns a 37-36 edge in the all-time dual meets ... The women's series is 14-4, Westminster.

Westminster Titans



The Westminster College men's and women's swimming teams defeated Baldwin-Wallace Saturday at the Westminster Natatorium ... The Titan men (7-2) won 118-72 and the Titan women (3-6) notched a 133-71 victory ... Junior **Becky Giles** broke the Westminster Nata-

torium record to win the 400-yard individual medley with a time of 4:43.31 ... The old pool record for the 400 IM was previously held by Jen Erdos of Allegheny with a time of 4.43.93 in 1996 ... Two Titan women's swimmers won multiple individual events, including senior freestyler Brittany Thomas and freshman freestyler Emily Dressler ... Thomas won the 1,000 freestyle (1:067.02) and the 500 freestyle (5:31.73) ... Dressler captured the 200 free (2:01.73) and the 100 free (56.20) ... On the men's side, senior All-American Rvan Trunk won the 50 and 100-vard freestyles with times of 22.23 and 48.54, respectively ... Over the holiday break, the Titans participated in a training trip in California ... During the trip, Westminster swept Occidental by scores of 133-70 (men) and 120-69 (women).

The Saint Vincent men's & women's swimming teams swept PAC rival Bethany Saturday, with the men winning 83-64 and the women edging the Bison 100-95 ... Kristy Hartbauer

earned three first place finishes against Bethany, winning the 200 breaststroke, the 100 freestyle, and was part of the winning 200 medley relay team ... Erin Perry had a pair of victories in the 100 breaststroke an the 200 backstroke ... Josh Shrum was a two-time winner on the day as well, scoring in the 200 freestyle and as part of the 200 medley relay team ... He was joined on that team by Jon Okonak and Greg Jackson, who also won individual events ... Okonak also won the 50 freestyle, while Jackson won the 100 backstroke.

Seniors Justin McMichael (1000 free. 11:37.48) and Ryan Johnson (100 free, 53.23) and freshmen Dan Martin (100 breastroke, 1:05.71) and Andrew Forish (50 freestyle, 23.35) notched first place to lead the W&J men to the win ... Saturday, junior Kaitlyn Orstein recorded four victories (2 indiv., 2 relay) to pace the W&J women ... She claimed the 100 (1:05.13) and 200 (2:25.31) breastroke events, while also helping the 200 freestyle (1:42.51) and 200 medley (1:54.53) relays to wins ...
