Mancuso earned the award for the second straight week after posting six wins for W&J. He won the 200 IM (2:02.53), 200 fly (2:02.61) and 500 free (4:51.13) in a 126-101 loss at Grove City. In a win against Bethany, he touched first in the 200 (1:49.02) and 500 free (4:59.53) events while adding a leg on the victorious 200 medley relay tam (1:45.53).

Also nominated was junior **Stephen Zinz** of Bethany, freshman **Mark Barron** of Grove City, and freshman **Zac Gebhardt** of Westminster.

PAC Women's Swimmer/Diver of the Week

Washington & Jefferson College Sophomore - freestyle/IM/butterfly

Orstein captured her third PAC weekly honor of the season after posting six wins (four individual) and breaking two pool and school records. She set a B-cut time (24.22) while winning the 50 free vs. Bethany, while helping the 200 free relay team (1:42.41) break an 11-year old pool record by nearly four seconds. At GCC, she won the 100 free in 10:33.00, breaking the school record by 17 seconds and the pool record by eight seconds, while also winning the 200 fly (2:12.05) and swimming for the victorious 400 freestyle relay (3:47.02).

Also nominated was freshman **Brenda Maxwell** of Bethany, senior **Jaclyn Bellissimo** of Grove City, and sophomore **Steph Peters** of Westminster.

Bethany's women won their first meet of the year Saturday with a triumph at future PAC foe St. Vincent ... Freshman **Brenda Maxwell** to-taled four first places, including wins in the 1,000 Free (12:00.80), 100 Free (1:01.40) and 500 Free (5:45.32) before leading off for the win-

ning 200 freestyle relay ... **Dana Culbert, Erin Staniech** and **Tricia Mark** also had a trio of firsts, which included all three competing on the victorious 200 medley relay (2:16.74) ... The men's team was defeated by the Bearcats, despite three firsts by **Stephen Zinz**, which included a sweep of 100 and 200 butterfly ... Both teams opened the week with a loss at W&J ... Culbert won the 100 backstroke (1:05.66) for the women, while Zinz touched first in the 100 butterfly (54.98) and the 200 medley relay team of **Noyan Eyigor**, Zinz, **Damien Sanzotti** and **Travis Edwards** lost by less than half a second.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents



The 20th-ranked W&J women's team posted a pair of victories during the week, including a 60point rout of Grove City on Saturday ... Sophomores **Kaitlyn Orstein** and **Kristen Mastropietro** and freshman **Susanne Seward** paced the W&J women with three wins each ... Orstein shattered the school record by 17 seconds during her firstplace finish in the 1000 freestyle with a time of

10:33.00 ... Her mark also set a new Grove City pool record by eight seconds ... Orstein followed that victory with a win in the 200 butterfly (2:12.05) and then teamed with Seward to touch first in the 400 freestyle relay (3:47.02) ... Mastropietro garnered first place in the 200 IM (2:20.04) and 200 breastroke (2:32.63), while Seward earned individual triumphs in the 50 (25.38) and 100 (55.86) freestyles. Mastropietro also helped the 400 medley relay team to an opening win in a time of 4:13.28 ... **Dan Mancuso** had his finest performance of his rookie year by earning first place in the 200 IM (2:02.53), 200 butterfly (2:02.61) and 500 freestyle (4:51.13) ... Orstein led the women's squad versus Bethany with a pair of individual victories and a new pool record in the 200 freestyle relay ... Senior **Andrew Pratt** and Mancuso led the men's team with a pair of individual wins against the Bison.

Grove City will recognize its 12 total seniors next Saturday on Senior Day against Wooster.



Westminster Titans

The Westminster swimming teams each recorded non-conference dual meet Saturday at Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea, Ohio ... The Titan men tallied a 122-83 victory, while the Lady Titans were victorious by a score of 141-64 ... The Westminster women were paced by triple-winner **Steph Peters**, as the sophomore touched first in both the 100 (56.23) and 200 frestyle (2:00.17), while also an-choring the victorious 200 freestyle relay team (1:45.50) ... She was joined on the winning relay by

classmate **Becky Giles**, who also won the 200 individual medley (2:15.18) ... Other double winners included senior **Megan Sweithelm** and junior **Megan McLaughlin**, who captured the 100 backstroke (1:02.35) and 50 freestyle (26.21), respectively, while also both swimming legs for the winning 200 medley relay team (1:57.64) ... On the men's side, freshman **Zac Gebhardt** made an immediate impact in his first dual meet for the Titans since transferring from Division I West Virginia, as he captured both the 500 (4:55.77) and 1000 freestyle (9:58.30) events to become the lone double-winner of the day for the Titans ... Both Westminster swim teams return to the pool this Tuesday (Jan. 17), as they host PAC rival Grove City for a dual meet at the Natatorium at 6 p.m. ... Both the Titans and Lady Titans are currently 2-0 in PAC competition.
