Senior - freestyle/butterfly/IM Allison Park, Pa./North Allegheny H.S.

Jardine won five events last week, sweeping three events in a win over Allegheny while winning twice vs. Carnegie Mellon. She won the 50 freestyle (25.99) and 100 butterfly (1:01.23) while swimming anchor for the 200 freestyle relay (1:47.97) against the Gators, then won the 400 IM (4:51.76) and 200 butterfly (2:14.22) at CMU.

Also nominated was sophomore **Dana Culbert** of Bethany, senior **Peggy Whitbeck** of Grove City, and junior **Erin Boyle** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC SWIMMING NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bethany men finished first in 10 events against PS-Altoona, led by freshman Stephen Zinz and sophomore Damien Sanzotti who each won three individual events ... Zinz won the 1000 free (11:24.94), the 100 fly (58.79) and the 500 free (5:31.50), while Sanzotti was victorious in the 200 individual medley (2:19.97), the 100 free (55.09) and the 100 breast (1:08.22) ... Trevor Hayes won the 1 and 3-meter diving events, Ben Brownlee won the 100 backstroke (1:05.57), and Brownlee, Michael Giovanetti, Yuki Shimizu and Hayes won the 200 free relay in 1:58.73 ... The Bison women recorded six first-place finishes ... Sophomore Dana Culbert won all three of the events in which she participated; the 50 free (26.26), 100 free (57.24) and she led off the winning 200 free relay team (1:56.21) ... The rest of the relay was composed of Emily Young, Courtney Wright and Ashley Richards ... Rachel Yakubik won both diving events, and Young won the 50 free (5:56.90).

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J coach Mike Orstein recorded his 300th career coaching victory on Saturday as the W&J men knocked off Grove City, 126-105 ... The win was also Orstein's 240th at W&J ... The W&J women dropped a 124-112 decision to the Lady Wolverines on the afternoon's final relay ... Senior Chris Shively paced four double winners on the men's side with wins in the 50 freestyle (23.03) and 200 breastroke (2:18.67) ... Junior Andrew Pratt captured the 200 backstroke (2:04.77) and 1000 freestyle (10:35.44), while sophomore Matt Socha claimed top honors in the 200 IM (2:04.91) and 500 freestyle (5:08.13) ... Senior Dan Bryner won both diving events, taking the 1-meter (182.15 points) and 3-meter platform (143.45 points) ... Junior Erin Boyle won the 200 backstroke (2:20.06) for the women, while senior Vanessa Tome finished first in the 200 breastroke (2:37.01) ... Junior Abby Leslie also notched first in 1-meter diving (213.30 points) ... In the loss to CMU, Boyle captured the 200 IM (2:19.77) and the 100 breastroke (1:04.97) ... Freshman Amy Plotkin won the 500 freestyle in a time of 5:30.30.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's women picked up a pair of victories last week, clinching their second straight winning season ... Christine Bare, Ellen Magee and Peggy Whitbeck all earned a pair of individual wins against Washington and Jefferson ... That trio joined Carolyn Shaddak on Grove City's winning 400 free relay effort that clinched the victory ... At Mount Union, Whitbeck rang up wins in the 100 fly, 200 IM and 1000 to help lead the Wolverines to a non-league win ... On the men's side, senior Drew McKelvy won the 100 and 200 free against Washington and Jefferson ... He also won the 50 against Mount Union while John Newell claimed top honors in the 200 and 500 free at Mount Union ... The Grove City men need to defeat either Penn State Behrend or Wooster this week in order to clinch the program's 53rd consecutive winning season.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster swim teams each went 1-1 last week, sweeping Allegheny before falling to Carnegie Mellon ... The men's win against the Gators was a historic one for Westminster, as it marked the 300th dual meet victory in the history of the Titan men's swimming program ... Three Titans were double winners ... Freshman Ryan Trunk led the way with individual wins in the 100 (50.38) and 200 freestyle (1:49.22) events ... Sophomores Josh Hensler and Nate Horrell both swam a leg on the winning 200 medley relay team (1:42.09) while also posting individual wins ... Hensler captured the 200 individual medley (2:05.76), while Horrell was victorious in the 100 butterfly (56.27) ... For the Lady Titans, senior Brittany Jardine led the way with wins in all three of her events ... Jardine captured both the 50 freestyle (25.99) and 100 butterfly (1:01.23) while swimming the anchor leg for the winning 200 freestyle relay team (1:47.97) ... The other Lady Titan to post a pair of individual wins was freshman Sara Bonchosky, who won both the 100 (56.11) and 200 freestyle (2:01.45).
