McKelvy captured all three of his events to lead Grove City to a 131.5-99.5 win over PAC rival Washington & Jefferson. He won both the 100 free (:50.79) and 200 free (1:51.37) while swimming a leg for GCC's winning 400 free relay team.

Jardine posted wins in six events (four individual, two relay) in dual meets against Allegheny and Carnegie Mellon last week. She won the 100 fly (1:00.45) and 200 free (1:59.99) while anchoring the winning 200 free relay (1:44.12) against Allegheny. She then captured the 200 free (2:00.63) and 200 fly (2:13.41) against CMU, while swimming on the winning 400 medley relay (4:12.90).

Also nominated was junior **Emily Young** of Bethany, junior **Peggy Whitbeck** of Grove City, and sophomore **Erin Boyle** of Washington & Jefferson.

Bethany Bison

The Bison dropped to 0-4 after being swept at Hiram Saturday ... The men were led by a pair of double-winners, as **Kenko Nagai** won the 200M Butterfly (2:11.96) and 200M Breaststroke (2:29.73), while **Joe Kennedy** claimed first in both diving events ... Nagai's times were not only good for first place but also set Hiram pool records ... The women had one double winner, while a pair of freshmen touched first in one event... Junior **Emily Young** earned first in the 400M Freestyle (5:06.27) and 800M (10:56.72), while **Dana Culbert** (1:04.30 in 100M Freestyle) and **Katie Raynovich** (2:58.77 in 200M IM) were victorious in their events.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The W&J women's squad defeated Grove City on Saturday led by sophomore **Abby Leslie**, who claimed both diving events ... Leslie won the 1-meter event with 235.4 points and also claimed the 3-meter event with 210.8 points ... Junior **Vanessa Tome** and sophomores **Erin Boyle** and **Jamie Chwan** also earned first-place finishes in the victory ... Chwan captured the 50 freestyle (26.40), while Boyle took home first-place honors in the 200 backstroke (2:19.07) ... Tome also won the 200 breaststroke (2:34.18) in the meet's last individual event ... On the men's side, sophomore **Andrew Pratt** led the way with a pair of individual triumphs ... He claimed the 500 (5:01.77) and 1000 (10:24.15) freestyle events ... Junior **Dan Bryner** also picked up victories in both diving events ... His 168.5 points placed first in the 1-meter event and he earned the diving sweep with 151.5 points on the 3-meter platform ... Junior **Chris Shively** also won the 50 freestyle (23.06), while sophomore **Sebastian Hesse** rounded out the Presidents' individual victors in the 200 butterfly with a time of 2:12.97.

Westminster split a pair of non-conference meets last week, posting a sweep at Allegheny on Friday before falling at home to Carnegie Mellon on Saturday ... Three Titans posted double wins in individual events in the victory ... Seniors **Jim Mann** and **Seth Bontrager** each had a pair of victories, with Mann capturing the 100 backstroke and 200 freestyle and Bontrager winning both the 100 butterfly and 200 IM ... Joining them was junior **Matt Buzard**, a double winner in the 50 and 100 freestyle ... The Lady Titans were paced by junior **Brittany Jardine**, the team's lone double winner in the 100 butterfly and 200 freestyle, while also swimming a leg for the victorious 200 freestyle relay team ... Joining Jardine in the relay win and as individual winners were senior **Amanda Zelechowski** and junior **Megan Lytle**, who captured the 200 IM and 50 freestyle, respectively ... Mann was the lone Titan winner versus CMU, winning the 200 backstroke (2:01.08) ...
