Coppelli won both backstroke events for Grove City Saturday, as the Wolverines defeated PAC rival Washington &

Jefferson 195-94. He posted a time of 55.64 in the 100 backstroke and a mark of 2:01.98 in the 200 back, while also swimming a leg for GCC's victorious 400 freestyle relay team, which touched first in 3:19.59.

Jones won three diving events last week, helping W&J top PAC rivals Bethany (122-84) and Grove City (165-128) and com-

plete a perfect 4-0 conference record in 2007-08. Against Bethany, she finished first in both the 1-meter (175.35) and 3-meter (162.20) events, while also winning the 3-meter event (169.95) versus Grove City.

Also nominated was junior **Brenda Maxwell** of Bethany, sophomore **Amy Kuuskoski** of Chatham, and freshman **Sarah Page** of Grove City.

PAC SWIMMING & DIVING NOTES

Bethany Bison



Swimming for the first time since early December, the Bison women split a pair of dual meets last week, while the Bethany men dropped

both ... Against W&J, Desiree Finley earned second in both diving events, scoring 167.60 on the one-meter and 160.90 in the three-meter event ... For the men, Kenny Drombosky finished second in the 200 Fly (2:16.35) ... Saturday, the BC women used a big performance from Brenda Maxwell to their second win of the year. a 134-112 win over Saint Vincent ... Maxwell won all four of her events, including victories in the 1000 Free (11:55.84), 100 Breast (1:18.18) and 500 Free (5:48.14), then swam a leg on the victorious 400 Free Relay ... The other members of that relay, Suzanne Stettinius, Jillian Zewe and Erin Staniech, also had good days ... Staniech won the 100 Back (1:06.88) and 50 Free (27.06), Zewe took first in the 200 Back (2:29.44) and second in the 200 and 100 Fly, while Stettinius earned second in the 200, 50 and 100 Free ... On the men's side. Nic Yacobi was second in the 50 Free (24.62) and Drombosky was second in the 100 Fly (56.74) and 200 Fly (2:16.75).

Saint Vincent Bearcats



Both Saint Vincent swim teams returned to action on Saturday after a sixweek hiatus, as they faced Bethany ... The Bearcat defeated the Bison 80-63, while the Lady Bearcats were de-

feated 134-112 ... Joe Bruzda. Eric Clouse. and Josh Shrum all had big days for the Bearcat men. as Bruzda won the 200 and 500 freestyle and was a member of victorious relay squads in the 200 medley (with Shrum, Clouse, and Jon Okonak) and 500 freestyle (with Shrum, Greg Jackson, and Adam Honickack) ... Clouse picked up wins in the 100 & 200 butterfly and 200 IM, and Shrum won the 100 and 200 breaststroke ... For the SVC women, Olivia Cinberg picked up wins in both the 100 and 200 butterfly, while Amanda Haile won the 200 freestyle and 200 breaststroke ... The 200 medley relay team of Haile, Anna Conlin, Karli Buday, and Sarah Denning was also victorious ... Both teams are off until traveling to Washington & Jefferson on January 30th.

Chatham Cougars



Chatham hosted Penn State-Behrend in a dual meet Friday, winning 122-84 ... The Cougars won seven of 13 events, including both relays ... Sophomore

Amy Kuuskoski took first place in the 200 freestyle and 500 freestyle ... She also swam on the first place 400 freestyle relay team ... Chatham also got individual first place finishes from first-years **Sarah Rice** (200 breaststroke), **Courtney Crass** (100 freestyle), and **Rachael Moynihan** (200 backstroke).

Grove City Wolverines



Both Grove City teams opened 2008 Saturday against longtime rival Washington & Jefferson ... The men's squad earned its eighth straight win

as Wolverine swimmers captured 14 of 16 events ... Junior Tim Whitbeck won both the 50 and 100 free while sophomore Lincoln Larsen swept the breaststroke ... Cam Coppelli swept the backstroke ... Coppelli, Whitbeck. Drew Snvder and Jeremv Harbaugh capped the meet by winning the 400 free relay ... Joe Riddell won 1-meter diving while Kyle Grubbs won on the 3meter board ... The women are now 2-1 in the PAC ... Freshman Sarah Page won the 100 and 200 free while sophomore Amanda Thompson swept the backstroke events ...
