Courage posted eight total victories last week as Grove City posted dual wins over PAC rival Westminster (143.5-136.5, clinching an undefeated PAC regular

season for GCC) and Wooster (164-134). He captured the 100 (45.28) and 200 free (1:42.83) along with the 200 IM (1:57/16) in the win over the Titans, while anchoring the 200 medley relay (1:35.54). Against Wooster, he touched first in the 50 (21.31) & 100 free (47.01) along with two relays.

Orstein claimed four victories Friday as W&J knocked off 22nd-ranked Wooster 154-124. She led off the event by helping the 200 medley relay (1:54.09) post

a win, then captured the 100 breaststroke (1:04.73), 200 IM (2:08.54) and the 200 backstroke (pool-record 2:10.73). The two-time NCAA national champion has earned four PAC Swimmer of the Week honors this season.

### **Bethany Bison**



Bethany's swimmers competed in only one meet last week, hitting the pool at Frostburg State ... The Bison men dropped a 111-69 deci-

sion, while the Bethany women were edged by FSU 84-79 ... The BC men were spearheaded by senior Stephen Zinz, who won three individual events, including the 200meter IM (2:26.18), 100-meter butterfly (1:02.57) and 400-meter freestyle (5:03.44) ... Senior Garv Migliaccio also earned first in both diving events ... The women had two three-time winners, including Erin Staniech ... The Bison junior touched first in the 50meter freestyle (29.46), the 100 backstroke (1:18.56) and also swam on the victorious 200 freestyle relay team ... Freshman Desiree Finley also had a trio of wins, as she was first on the one- and three-meter diving boards and also swam on the 200 freestyle relay ... A third member of that relay, sophomore Brenda Maxwell, also won the 100 breaststroke (1:31.00).

## Westminster Titans



The Westminster men lost at Grove City 143.5-136.5 Tuesday before downing Saint Vincent, 145-94, at home Saturday, while the women beat Grove City, 149-98, and Saint Vincent, 144-87 ... Multiple winners for the Grove City meet included senior freestyler **Brittany Thomas** cap-

turing the 1,000 free (11:02.28) and the 500 free (5:26.20), sophomore Megan Mier winning the 100 (1:02.5) and 200 (2:11.73) backstroke and junior Becky Giles touching first in the 200 butterfly (2:14.68) and the 200 IM (2:15.67) ... Senior Pat Smith won the 100 (54.47) and 200 (1:57.31) backstrokes and sophomore Chris Lehberger clocked in first in the 100 (58.81) and 200 (2:09.82) breaststroke ... Against SVC, nine different Titan men won individual events and 10 different Titan women took first in races ... Sophomore Conor Simpson won the 200 free (1:51.25) and 500 free (4:59.55) ... Sophomore Cody Robson finished first in the 200 (2:10.26) and 100 (55.72) butterfly ... Senior Emily Staniszewski won the 100 backstroke (1:11.08) and the 200 IM (2:23.33) and freshman Emily Dressler captured the 100 free (57.16) and the 100 butterfly (1:04.59).



Grove City's men's swimming and diving team earned its first victory over Westminster in 11 years Tuesday, pulling out a 143.5-136.5 victory ...

The Wolverines clinched the victory by winning the meet-ending 400 free relay ... Junior Caleb Courage posted three individual wins against Westminster, winning the 100 free, 200 free and 200 IM ... Chip Cressman set a new GCC record in winning the 500 and also won the 1000 ... Tim Whitbeck won the 50 and contributed to two relay victories against the Titans ... Kyle Grubbs swept diving ... Grove City and Westminster are now tied 37-37 in the all-time series ... Against Wooster, Joe Riddell won both 1- and 3meter diving ... Riddell provisionally qualified for the NCAA Championships in 1-meter diving ... Courage posted four total wins, including individual victories in the 50 and 100 free ... On the women's side, freshman Jane Wilson picked up three wins against Westminster (50 & 100 free, 100 fly) ... At Wooster Saturday, Wilson won the 50 while junior Ellen Keefer captured the 200 free ... Grove City will honor its five seniors Friday night in a double-dual against Pitt-Bradford and Penn State-Behrend.
