Orstein won her second consecutive PAC women's swimmer of the week honor after winning three races (two individual and one relay) for the second straight meet. She set a new school record in the 100 backstroke (1:00.65) and also won the 50 free (24.75) in a win over Baldwin-Wallace, while helping lead the W&J 200 medley relay team (1:53.03) to victory.

PAC SWIMMING NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison men won their only meet of the week in nail-biting fashion, claiming a 111-107 victory over home-standing Frostburg State Saturday ... Bethany's women suffered a 137-58 defeat to the Maryland-based institution's swimmers ... For the men, **Stephen Zinz** recorded 18 individual points for the men and aided in gaining 11 more to help pace the Bison ... Zinz recorded meet-best times in the 200-meter freestyle and 200-meter butterfly ... He also anchored the 400-meter freestyle relay ... **Joe Kennedy** also took home top-billing for the Bison in two events, the 1- and 3-meter dives ... For the women, **Dana Culbert** continued to dominate for her Bison teammates, scoring victories in the 50- and 100-meter freestyles to rack up 18 individual points for the Bison.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J freshman Kaitlyn Orstein helped keep the Presidents' perfect dual meet season alive with three victories on Friday evening in a tight victory over Baldwin-Wallace ... Orstein helped the 200 medley relay squad open the meet with a victory in 1:53.03 ... Seniors Kristina Springborn and Erin Boyle and sophomore Brandi Shoupe joined Orstein in securing the meet-opening win ... Orstein set a new school record in her victory in the 100 backstroke (1:00.65), shaving a full second off the previous school mark. She also won the 50 freestyle with a time of 24.75 ... Boyle also garnered a victory in the 100 freestyle (57.21), while freshman Kristen Mastropietro took first place in the 100 breastroke (1:10.68) ... Freshman Kristina McClelland also captured top honors in the 1000 freestyle in a time of 11:18.60 ... Sophomore Ryan Johnson was the only President to record a victory on the men's side as he placed first in the 500 freestyle (5:25.94).

Grove City Wolverines

Both Grove City teams were off last week as the Wolverines' dual meet at Wooster was snowed out ... No makeup plans have been announced for that meet ... Grove City hosts PAC rival Westminster Tuesday night ... It is the 72^{nd} meeting between the two men's programs, with Grove City holding a 36-35 edge ... Friday, Grove City's women will face California, Pa. and Salem International in a double-dual at Cal ... The men will swim against Salem in a neutral-site meet ... Grove City will recognize its seven total seniors prior to Saturday's dual meet against Penn State Behrend ... Grove City will host the PAC Championships and Grove City Invitational Feb. 10-12.
