PAC Swimming & Diving 2009-10 - Week 10 Conference Notes

GREAT BEGINNINGS: Chatham's swim team earned two victories last weekend after a hiatus since Nov. 24, 2009 ... The SVC women won their second straight contest, beating WV Wesleyan 135-101 on Saturday afternoon ... PAC leaders Westminster and Grove City received losses to ranked opponents in Carnegie Mellon and Denison respectively ... The Wolverines honor diver Earl Mays ('63) as he enters the College's Hall of Fame.

SWIMMER'S HAT TRICK: Chatham's Emily Price led the Cougars with a "hat trick" of victories – the 1000 yard freestyle, the 200 individual medley, and the 100 breast stroke ... Westminster's Caitlin Lehberger set two new Westminster Natatorium records and also established a pair of NCAA Championship provisional qualifying "B" cut times ... She along with teammate, junior Courtney Herdt, posted "B" cut times in the 100 breaststroke.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Saint Vincent's Casey Whittaker earned a pair of individual wins for the Bearcats, including the 200 IM and the 200 Free ... Against Chatham, Bethany's Liz Rubash won the 50 Free for the third consecutive meet ... W&J's sweep of Penn State-Behrend produced two trivictory swimmers in **Brandon Smith** and **Jonathan** Weeks ... Patrick O'Toole touched first in the 1650 freestyle and notched the PAC's second-best time of the year in the event (17:20.60).

Bethany Bison (M: 0-7, 0-2 PAC; W: 2-6, 0-3 PAC)

The Bison opened the week by splitting a dual meet against Frostburg State ... The women's victory was sparked by freshman **Liz Rubash**, who swam the

anchor leg for the winning 400 Medley Relay and posted wins in the 50 Free (26.17) and 100 Free (58.88) ... Other multiple winners for Bethany were sophomore Sara Reass in the 1000 Free (12:48.11) and 500 Free (6:10.94) and Lindsay Arnold in the 400 Medley Relay and 100 Fly (1:09.32) ... Rounding out the top efforts was freshman Theresa Smith with a win in the 200 Free (2:18.45) and second in the 100 Fly ... For the men, freshman Nick Salvagni earned a pair of seconds in the 1000 Free (11:18.35) and 500 Free (5:22.43), with other runner-ups going to freshman Andrew Masterson in the 200 Free, freshman Vinnie Giangiulio in the 50 Free and senior Rich Sawyer in the 100 Fly ... Senior diver Desiree Finley headlined a good day for Bethany against Chatham, as she swept the 1-meter (182.90) and 3-meter (168.05) diving events and also took second in the 200 Breast ... Elsewhere in the pool, Rubash cruised to a win in the 50 Free in 25.75, which is less than a half-second off the school record, and Reass won the 500 Free with a season-best time of 6:10.71 and took second in the 1,650 Free.

Chatham Cougars (W: 6-3, 1-3 PAC)

Chatham competed this weekend for the first time since November 24, 2009, and came out with two victories ...

Friday night, the Cougars swam against Penn State Behrend in a non-conference dual meet and came out with the victory 115-103 ... Sophomore **Emily Price** led the Cougars with a "hat trick" of victories – the 1000 yard freestyle, the 200 individual medley, and the 100 breast stroke ... Other swimmers to contribute to the 115-103 non-conference victory were **Chelsea Mummert, Carly Hicks, Selina Breiner**, and **Lindsay Minnich** ... This quartet set a school record in the final event – the 200 freestyle relay – finishing with a time of 1:42.76 ... Chatham hit the water again Saturday afternoon and swam to their second victory of the weekend, defeating Bethany in Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) play ... Hicks had two individual victories in the meet, in the 200 backstroke and the 800 freestyle relay, and set a pool record for her time in the 800 freestyle relay ... Price, Mummert, Minnich, Breiner, and Ashten Omstead also contributed victories in the 400 individual medley, the 100 freestyle, 200 butterfly, 200 freestyle, and the 200 breast stroke, respectively.

Grove City Wolverines (M: 7-2, 1-0 PAC; W: 9-1, 2-0 PAC)

The Grove City College men's and women's swimming and diving squads both dropped their respective dual meet at Denison Saturday in non-conference action ...

On the men's side, Grove City dropped a 158-124 decision while the women's team came out on the short end of a 167-119 verdict ... The women had won a program-recrd 13 consecutive meets before Saturday's setback ... Freshman **Angela Palumbo** took second in both the 50 and 200 free for the Wolverines while sophomore diver **Bethany Johnson** placed second on both boards ... Senior diver **Kyle Grubbs** led the men's team by winning 1-meter diving ... Sophomore **Josh Kim** earned second in the 1000 ... Grove City hosts Penn State Behrend and Pitt-Bradford Friday in a double dual ... Saturday, the Wolverines welcome Wooster to the Longnecker Competition Pool as part of Hall of Fame Day at Grove City ... Standout diver **Earl Mays** '63 will enter the Hall of Fame Saturday.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (M: 1-7; W: 3-5)

The SVC women won their second straight, beating WV Wesleyan 135-101 on Saturday afternoon ... Katie Custer continued her stellar season for the Lady Bearcats, picking up a trio of individual victories, including

the 50 and 100-yard Freestyle, and the 100 Fly ... Jess Kennedy touched first in the 200 Free, while Jayna Cline led SVC in distance events, winning the 500 Free and taking second in the 1000 Free ... The foursome of Sarah Denning, Meredith Brown, Christine Dunleavy, and Maggie Dempsey teamed up to capture the 400 Medley Relay ... The Bearcat men were defeated 139-109 by WV Wesleyan on Saturday. Casey Whittaker earned a pair of individual wins for the Bearcats, including the 200 Individual Medley and the 200 Free ... The Bearcats were also able to sweep the 500 Free, with Zack Krejdovsky, Kreighton Long, and Adam Hodnichak taking the top three spots ... Adam Thomas took second in both the 100 and 200 Back, and Matt Snelick second in the 100 and 200 Breast.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (M: 5-5, 1-2 PAC; W: 7-4, 2-2 PAC)

The Washington & Jefferson College swimming and diving teams continued the dual-meet season on Saturday by sweeping Penn State-Behrend ... The Presidents' men were paced by junior **Brandon Smith**'s three victories ... He claimed the 200 freestyle (1:49.08), 200

backstroke (2:05.46) and the 200 IM (2:04.21) ... Sophomore **Jonathan Weeks** also earned a trio of victories for the Red & Black, winning the 200 butterfly (2:01.65), 100 free (49.58) and 100 butterfly (55.01) ... Freshman **Patrick O'Toole** touched first in the 1650 freestyle (17:20.60) and notched the conference's second-best time of the year in the event ... He then won the 500 freestyle in a time of 4:57.94 ... Sophomore **Bethany Haver** continued her recent string of dominance on the 1- and 3-meter diving boards, winning the 1-meter event with a score of 239.60 and collecting 236.00 points during the 3-meter triumph ... Sophomore **C.J. Corcoran** earned victories in the 100 breaststroke (1:10.46) and 500 freestyle (5:33.59), while freshman **Katlin Dagg** touched first in the 100 (1:03.51) and 200 (2:14.33) butterfly events.

afternoon ... The Titan men lost 183-113 and the Titan women lost 181-110 ... Sophomore Caitlin Lehberger set two new Westminster Natatorium records and also established a pair of NCAA Championship provisional qualifying "B" cut times ... Lehberger won the 200-yard breaststroke with a "B" cut and pool record time of 2:25.63 ... She also won the 400 individual medley with a pool-record time of 4:39.69 ... Both Lehberger and junior Courtney Herdt posted "B" cut times in the 100 breaststroke with Herdt placing first at 1:07.27, followed by Lehberger at 1:07.47 ... The other Westminster women's swimmer to win an event was senior Emily Dressler in the 1,000 freestyle (10:57.88) ... On the men's side, senior Ben Gutmann and sophomore Mike Barringer each collected a pair of event wins ...
