Westminster College Senior - backstroke/freestyle Indiana, Pa./The Kiski School

Mann won all three of his events as Westminster posted a 111-76 non-conference win at NCAA D-II Fairmont State. He won the 1000 freestyle (10:22.20) while swimming legs for the winning 200 medley (1:44.51) and 200 freestyle (1:33.91) relay teams.

Also nominated was freshman **Noyan Eyigor** of Bethany, junior **Rich Korb** of Grove City, and sophomore **Sebastian Hesse** of Washington & Jefferson.

PEGGY WHITBECK

Grove City College Junior - butterfly/distance Saegertown, Pa./Saegertown H.S.

Whitbeck captured both the 200 freestyle (2:06.78) and the 500 freestyle (5:13.08) for Grove City in the Lady Wolverines' 134-79 loss at nationally-rankeed Wooster. Her time in the 200 free set a new Wooster pool record.

Also nominated was freshman **Dana Culbert** of Bethany, sophomore **Jennifer Fleagle** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior **Brittany Jardine** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

After both teams lost Wednesday at Frostburg, the women won their meet of the year at PSU-Altoona ... **Kenko Nagai** was the lone double-winner against Frostburg, taking the 200meter Butterfly and 200-meter Breaststroke ... **Emily Young** (800-meter Freestyle) and **Dana Culbert** (100-meter Freestyle) were winners on the women's side ... Culbert helped lead the women to victory against Altoona with first places in the 50and 100-yard Freestyles, while **Becky Repasky** (100-yard Backstroke) and **Katie Raynovich** (100-yard Butterfly) also won events... The men's team was led by **Joe Kennedy**, who swept the diving events, and **Noyan Eyigor**, who won the 100-yard Backstroke for the second consecutive meet ... In his only event of the day, Nagai recorded a time of 59.54 to win the 100-yard Breaststroke.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The W&J women improved to 6-1 overall, while the men's team improved to 4-3 following a dual meet sweep of Baldwin-Wallace on Friday in Berea, Ohio ... The women's squad defeated the Yellow Jackets, 136-107, while the W&J men picked up a 139-86 victory ... Junior Vanessa Tome and sophomore Jennifer Fleagle led the way for the W&J women with two victories ... Tome won the 200 freestyle (2:04.84) and the 100 breastroke (1:13.00), while Fleagle captured the 500 (5:27.95) and 1000 (11:09.35) freestyle events ... Sophomore Erin Boyle also took home first-place honors in the 100 backstroke (1:04.40) ... Junior Chris Shively and sophomore Sebastian Hesse paced the President men with two wins each ... Shively earned first place in the 50 (23.41) and 100 (51.67) freestyle, while Hesse continued W&J's success in the freestyle events with victories in the 200 (1:53.92) and 500 (5:21.83) ... Sophomore Andrew Pratt won the 1000 (10:48.78) by 38 seconds ... Freshman Phil Capron won the 100 back (58.91), while junior Dan Bryner won the 1-meter diving (142.5).

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverine men won seven of 13 events but could not secure their 52nd consecutive winning season Saturday with the defeat, which snapped their five-meet winning streak ... **Rich Korb** and **Bob Young** were both triple-winners as Korb won the 500 and 1000 free ... Korb and Young were both on the 400 free relay while Young contributed to GCC's winning 400 medley relay effort ... Young also won the 200 back while **Andrew Gilbert** won the 200 breaststroke ... **Drew McKelvy** won the 200 freestyle ... On the women's side, **Peggy Whitbeck** established a new Wooster pool record in winning the 200 butterfly Saturday ... Whitbeck also won the 500 free and **Jacquie Adlam** won the 200 breaststroke for Grove City.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster College men's and women's swimming teams each captured non-conference dual meets Saturday at NCAA Division II Fairmont State University in Fairmont, W.Va.... The Titan men improved to 4-2 with a 111-76 victory, while the Lady Titans evened their dual record at 3-3 with a 109-82 win over FSU ... Leading the way for the Titan men was sophomore Luke Downer, who was the team's lone double winner in individual events ... Downer captured both the 100 & 200 freestyle events ... Senior Jim Mann was unbeaten in all three events he entered, winning the 1000 freestyle while swimming legs for the winning 200 medley and 200 freestyle relay teams ... Pacing the Lady Titan victory was the duo of junior Brittany Jardine and freshman Kelly Rovnak ... Jardine swept three individual events, capturing the 200 butterfly, 400 individual medley and 500 freestyle ... Rovnak was a double-winner for the Westminster women, winning both the 200 backstroke and 1000 freestyle events ... Westminster hosts Bethany on Tuesday, then faces W&J on Saturday at Hiram.
