Bethany Bison



Six different Bison won events to help the Bethany women's team to a 134-112 win over Frostburg State Saturday ... It was BC's third

dual meet win of the season, their most since the 1999-2000 season ... The day started on a winning note for the Bison with the 400 medley relay team of freshman Jillan Zewe, junior Katie Cunningham, freshman Suzanne Stettinius and sophomore Jessica Sarro taking first in 4:53.59 ... Senior Erin Staniech, swimming in her final home meet, captured first place in the 50 (26.86) and 100 free (58.78) ... Stettinius completed the Bethany sweep of the sprints by winning the 200 free (2:12.06) ... Other individual winners included junior Brenda Maxwell in the 200 I.M. (2:34.93) and Zewe in the 200 backstroke (2:32.16) ... In diving, sophomore Desiree Finley took first in the one-meter event with a season-best score of 181.00, while freshman Sara Patnesky won the three-meter competition (164.25) ... The men's team was defeated by the Bobcats 80-63, but freshman Kenny Drombosky touched first in a pair of events, including the 50 free (22.94) and the 200 butterfly (2:18.18).

Both Grove City teams dropped dual meets at Westminster and Denison last week ... On the women's side, freshmen Sarah Page and Sarah Bargery

both earned two win each at Westminster ... Page won the 50 and 100 freestyle, while Bargery swept the breaststroke ... Rebecca Smiddy won the 1000 ... Bargery, Amanda Thompson, Lauren Baur and Ellen Keefer won the 200 medlev relay at Westminster while Keefer, Baur, Page and Katie Brunk won the 400 free relay ... At Denison Saturday, freshman diver Stephanie McNeill took third on both boards to lead Grove City ... For the men, junior Tim Whitbeck earned a pair of wins in the 50 free ... He posted a victorious time of 20.84 at Westminster, then won the 50 at Denison in 20.74 seconds ... It's the first time Grove City dropped backto-back dual meets under sixth-year head coach Dave Fritz ... Grove City did drop a double-dual against Case Western and Kenyon in 2005 ... Grove City will visit Penn State Behrend Friday night for a double dual with Pitt-Bradford.

Brandon Smith paced the W&J men with four victories ... Smith collected three individual wins starting with the 200 freestyle (1:49.84) ... He then touched first in the 100 (49.77) and 500 (509.53) freestyle events, while also leading the 200 medley relay to a win in a time of 1:42.09 ... Freshman Maxwell Mock notched three individual wins ... He won the 1000 freestyle (11:07.45) and then posted first-place showings in the 200 backstroke (2:05.85) and 200 IM (2:09.13) ... Sophomore Mark Sirkoch and freshman Brandon Boyer joined Smith on the medley relay, while also helping the 400 freestyle relay to a victory (3:32.21) ... Senior Jessica Wightman swam on the 200 medley relay and then grabbed first place in the 100 freestyle (57.10) ... Senior Kaitlyn Orstein and junior Brittany Bertoli each won a pair of individual events ... Saturday's meet marks Senior Day for five Washington & Jefferson College swimmers.

Westminster Titans



The Westminster men's and women's swim teams split a pair of home dual meets this week vs. Grove City Tuesday and Carnegie

Mellon Saturday ... The Titan men defeated Grove City, 152-102, and lost to Carnegie Mellon, 115-88, while the Titan women beat Grove City, 146-116, and lost to CMU, 108-95 ... Junior Megan Mier and sophomore Emily Dressler each won three individual events for the week ... Dressler took the 200 freestyle in both meets and the 500 freestyle vs. Grove City ... Mier won the 200 back in both meets and the 100 back vs. Grove City ... Five different Titan men won multiple events for the week, including sophomore Ben Gutmann winning the 100 and 200 breaststroke events and freshman Devin Gannon capturing the 100 and 200 backstroke races in the win over Grove City.
