Orstein led the W&J men's squad to a 122-96 win over Baldwin-Wallace last week by anchoring two relay victories for the Presidents (400 Medley & 400 Freestyle) while also claiming first place honors in the 200 individual medley (2:09.68).

Both Bison teams fell to 0-6 on the year after being swept by Frostburg State ... On the women's side, sophomore **Emily Young** won the 1000 freestyle with a time of 12:26.45 ... Also, senior **Tiffany Krohn** won the one-meter diving event and her score of 203.4 broke the College record in the event, set by **Megan Warden** in 1999 with a score of 201.85 ... For the men, senior **T.J. Howell** claimed the one-meter diving event with a score of 171.10.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The W&J men's and women's swimming and diving squads swept a dual meet from Baldwin-Wallace on Friday evening in Washington, Pa. ... Sophomore Jepthah Orstein led the men's team with a pair of victories in relays (400 Medley, 400 Freestyle) and a first-place finish in the 200 IM in a time of 2:09.68 ... Freshman Andrew Pratt picked up victories in the 500 (5:12.72) and 1000 Freestyle (10:36.16) events, while sophomore Chris Shively claimed first-place in the 50 Freestyle (23.48) and 200 Breastroke (2:20.50) ... Senior Mike Yee also captured first place in both the 1-Meter (195.85) and 3-Meter (200.65) diving events ... On the women's side, freshman Abby Leslie was the night's top winner with three individual victories: the 50 (26.80) and 100 (58.44) Freestyle events and 1-Meter diving (237.00 points) ... The W&J women got off to a quick start as senior Jennifer Hensell and freshmen Jamie Chwan, Kellie McNamara and Kristina Springborn won the 400 Medley Relay in a pool-record time of 4:18.46 in the first race of the night.

Grove City Wolverines

Sophomore **Peggy Whitbeck** turned in the Lady Wolverines' top performance in their 117-109 loss to Wooster on Saturday, placing first in the 200-yard butterfly with an NCAA provisional qualifying time of 2:09.23 ... Whitbeck added a secondplace finish in the 200 individual medley with a time of 2:14.68 ... Sophomore **Julie Pullin** contributed second-place points in the 200 backstroke, touching in 2:21.07 ... Wooster is expected to place among the top 10 teams in the nation at this year's NCAA Division III Swimming & Diving Championships. The Scot women have finished in the top 20 at nationals 13 times over the past 17 seasons.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's and women's swim teams each improved to 5-1 Friday with a home sweep of Fairmont State College ... Leading the way for the Titan men was sophomore Matt Buzard with individual victories in the 50 (:22.03) and 100 freestyle (:48.51) events, as well as swimming a leg on the victorious 200 medley relay team ... Also a dual winner for the Titan men was junior Seth Bontrager in the 400 individual medley (4:17.32) and the 200 butterfly (2:01.26) ... With a win in the 200 breaststroke, senior Kurt Rotthoff set a new pool record of 2:11.71, breaking the mark of 2:12.74 set by Andrew Smearman of Clarion in 1995 ... For the Lady Titans, three swimmers posted victories in two individual and one relay event each ... Senior Jaime Sell won both the 200 (2:00.37) and 500 freestyle (5:22.63) events ... Classmate Karen Faulhaber was victorious in the 50 (:26.21) and 100 freestyle (:56.76) events ... Sophomore Brittany Jardine won the 400 individual medley (4:51.43) and the 200 butterfly (2:17.16).
