tured both the 500 (4:59.52) and 100) (10:29.11) freestyle events against SVC, then was a triple-winner at Hiram in the 100 butterfly (1:04.70), 400 freestyle (4:28.40) and 800 freestyle (9:25.26).

Wightman racked up four wins during the week for the Presidents, including three in an 81-68 PAC win over Saint Vincent. Against SVC, she swam the first



leg of the winning 200 medley (1:56.16) and 200 freestyle (1:50.23) relays, while also capturing the 100 freestyle (57.25). Wightman then helped the 200 free relay (1:57.30) to victory at Hiram in a 134-100 W&J win.

Also nominated was sophomore **Brenda Maxwell** of Bethany, freshman **Jane Wilson** of Grove City, and senior **Brittany Thomas** of Westminster.

The Bison completed their dual meet schedule last week, with the women competing against Chatham and both teams swimming

against Mount Union ... In the Chatham meet, sophomore Brenda Maxwell took first in a pair of events, which included touching first in the 100 breaststroke (1:19.19) and the 200 breaststroke (2:53.59) ... Junior Erin Staniech finished second in three events, including the 50 freestyle, 200 freestyle and 200 backstroke and sophomore Mallory Lee placed second in the 100 backstroke and 100 freestyle ... In the Mount Union meet. the Bison had a pair of first places, as Staniech won the 50 freestyle (26.82) and Maxwell was victorious in the 100 freestyle (1:01.65) ... For the men, senior Gary Migliaccio earned first place in both diving events and senior Stephen Zinz finished second in a close race in the 200 butterfly.

Westminster Titans



The Westminster College men's and women's swimming teams absorbed nonconference losses at Carnegie Mellon Saturday ... The Titan men (8-4) lost 157-105 and the Titan women (5-7) fell 139-123 ... Westminster won a combined 11 races (5 men, 6 women), as four Titan

swimmers won multiple events ... For the women, senior freestyler Brittany Thomas won the 1,000 (11:02.72) and 500 (5:26.95) freestyle races, while sophomore Megan Mier captured the 100 (1:01.82) and 200 (2:11.70) backstroke events ... Sophomore Caitlin McManus won the 100 breaststroke (1:11.35) and junior Becky Giles took the 400 individual medley (4:44.06) ... On the men's side, sophomore Chris Lehberger won the 100 (1:00.44) and 200 (2:10.29) breaststroke races, while senior All-American Rvan Trunk touched first in the 50 (21.88) and the 100 (47.07) freestyle events ... Senior Pat Smith also won the 200 backstroke (1:57.33).



Both Grove City teams closed the 2006-07 dual-meet season last weekend, with each team earning three victories ... Friday night, the GCC women

downed Penn State-Behrend and received a forfeit win from Pitt-Bradford ... Jane Wilson won the 50 and 100 free for Grove City while Ellen Keefer took the 200 ... Also earning wins were: Rebecca Smiddy (1000), Alvse Brannon (100 back). Rachel Johnson (200 back) and Whitney Baur (200 IM) ... Wilson, Keefer, Kiersten Bower and Virginia Larsen won the 200 medley relay ... Wilson won the 100 Saturday in a double dual at D-II foe California, Pa. ... Grove City's men set a new program record for singleseason wins with 15 ... Grove City's 14-meet win streak is its longest since 1996 ... Friday night, junior diver Joe Riddell set a new GCC pool record in 1-meter diving with 284.00 points on six dives, provisionally qualifying for the NCAA Division III Championships ... Freshman Rich Albertson swept the backstroke Friday while Luke Wiedeman (1000), Mark Barron (200 free), Mitch Young (50), Nick Barker (200 fly) and Andrew Gilbert (100 breast) all notched wins.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



The Saint Vincent men's & women's swimming teams closed the 2006-07 regular season by suffering sweeps against PAC opponent W&J (135-68 men, 81-65 women) and at D-II 121-101 men, 113-97

Fairmont State (121-101 men, 113-97 women) ... Katie Bittner set a school record in the 1000 freestyle (12:06.79) and also won the 500 freestyle against Fairmont State ... Erin Perry's time of 2:28.57 in the 200 backstroke at Fairmont State was also a school record ... Jon Okonak won the 50 and 100 freestyle events against W&J, while Eric Clouse won the 100 butterfly ... Clouse won the 50 freestyle and 200 IM against Fairmont State, while Okonak captured the 100.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents



The W&J men's and women's swimming and diving teams wrapped up their regular-season schedules with a sweep of Hiram Saturday ... The 12 victories are the second-most in school history

for the W&J women, trailing only the 2004-05 Presidents' 13-0 mark ... The men suffered four of their five losses to teams ranked in the top 25 ... All times were recorded in a meter pool ... Junior Kaitlvn Orstein and sophomore Daniel Mancuso paced their respective squads ... Orstein set pool records and qualified for the NCAA "B" cut in the 200 freestyle (2:07.49) and 100 butterfly (1:05.26) ... She also led the 200 medley relay team to a win (2:08.19) ... Mancuso claimed first in three events after touching first in the 100 butterfly (1:04.70), 400 freestyle (4:28.40) and 800 freestyle (9:25.26) ... Sophomore Alicia Sutton earned first in the 400 (4:52.77) and 800 (10:01.97) freestyle events ... She then led the 200 freestyle relay to a victory in 1:57.30 ... Sophomores Zach Nigrelli and Eddie Werner also grabbed two wins ... Nigrelli was first in the 100 (1:04.73) and 200 (2:04.52) freestyles, while Werner was first in the 100 back (56.34) and 200 IM (2:23.17).
