# PAC Men's Swimmer/Diver of the Week BEN HARING

### **Grove City College**

Junior - sprint freestyle Kenai, Ala./Kenai Central H.S.

Harting was a triple-winner for the Wolverines in their 119-118 PAC loss to Westminster Tuesday, capturing the 50 freestyle (21.47) while swimming legs for the winning 400 freestyle and 400 medley relay teams. Saturday against Penn State-Behrend, he became the first swimmer this season to defeat teammate Caleb Courage in the 50 freestyle this season, posting a time of 21.46 (third-fastest in school history).

Also nominated was senior **Sebastian Hesse** of Washington & Jefferson and junior **Josh Hensler** of Westminster.

# PAC Women's Swimmer/Diver of the Week KAITLYN ORSTEIN

### Washington & Jefferson College

Freshman - individual medley/breaststroke Mount Lebanon, Pa./Mount Lebanon

Orstein won her third consecutive PAC women's swimmer of the week honor after sweeping six races (four individual and two relay) in W&J wins over Penn State-Behrend and Hiram. She posted "A cut" times in four events and set six new pool records and four new school records. Orstein defeated last year's NCAA Division III champion, Beth Groselle of Hiram, in the 100 breast-stroke by over two seconds.

Also nominated was junior **Dana Culbert** of Bethany, senior **Christine Bare** of Grove City, and sophomore **Sara Bonchosky** of Westminster.

# PAC SWIMMING NOTES

### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison men and women both head into the PAC Championship meet following losses in their final meet ... The men – in their only meet of the week – fell to Mount Union Saturday 116-94 ... **Joe Kennedy** spotted his men, winning both the 1-and 3-meter diving events ... The women claimed victory over Chatham College (104-77) earlier in the week before succumbing to Mount Union (110-74) Saturday ... Against Chatham, three swimmers – **Erin Staniech**, **Dana Culbert** and **Tallie Stettinius** – scored two first-place finishes for the Bison ... In falling to Mount Union, Culbert claimed two victories in the 50-and 100-meter freestyle competitions before last-minute victories by **Ashley Richards** and the 400-yard freestyle relay team added points to the women's total.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The W&J women's squad completed its first undefeated dual meet season since the 1993-94 Presidents accomplished the feat with an 11-0 mark ... The 13-0 dual meet record is the best in program history ... In the win over Hiram, freshman Kaitlyn Orstein continued to lead the Presidents with three victories ... Orstein, who was matched against last year's national champion in the 100 breaststroke, Hiram's Beth Groselle, set a new pool record and qualified for the NCAA "A" cut in the 100 breaststroke (1:12.20) ... Orstein was nearly two seconds under the NCAA qualifying standard and she topped Groselle's season-best time (1:14.14) by just under two seconds ... Orstein also defeated Groselle during her pool record and NCAA "A" cut time of 2:20.31 in the 200 individual medley ... Senior Kristina Springborn also touched first in the 100 backstroke (1:11.21), while sophomore Lindsay Biddle placed first in the 1-meter diving event with 180.25 points ... On the men's side, sophomore Matt Ide was W&J's lone first-place finisher with a victory in the 3-meter diving event (117.60 points).

# **Grove City Wolverines**

Both Grove City teams closed the dual-meet portion of the schedule Saturday with wins over Penn State Behrend ... The men's team clinched its 54th straight winning season Friday night by defeating NCAA D-II Salem International ... Caleb Courage won the 50 free and 100 back while Jeremy Harbaugh won the 400 IM ... Seven different Wolverines had wins against Behrend Saturday ... Courage had two individual wins against Westminster ... Grove City's women clinched their third straight winning season Saturday by downing Behrend ... Christine Bare won the 200 IM and 500 free Saturday while Emily Hays won the 1- and 3-meter diving competition ... Bare also had two wins in a double-dual against Salem International and California, Pa. ... Grove City will host the Grove City Invitational and PAC Championships Feb. 10-12 ... The Grove City men and Westminster women are the defending conference champions as well as the defending Invitational titlists.

### Westminster Titans

Westminster posted sweeps at PAC rival Grove City on Tuesday and at home vs. Baldwin-Wallace Saturday ... Five Titan men captured individual events to edge Grove City ... For the Lady Titans, both sophomore Sara Bonchosky and freshman Becky Giles were triple winners against the Wolverines ... Bonchosky captured both the 200 (1:59.25) and 500 freestyle (5:23.04) while leading off the victorious 400 freestyle relay (3:47.65), while Giles touched first in both the 200 IM (2:16.53) and 200 backstroke (2:17.23) while leading off the winning 400 medley relay (4:12.56) ... On the men's side vs. B-W, sophomore Ryan Trunk was a triple-winner for the Titans, capturing both the 50 (22.08) and 100 freestyle (48.60) while leading off the 200 freestyle relay (1:28.12) ... For the Lady Titans, Bonchosky and Megan McLaughlin led the way with two individual wins each ... Bonchosky won both the 100 freestyle (55.32) and the 200 IM (2:19.27), while McLaughlin finished in front of the 200 backstroke (2:14.58) and the 1000 freestyle (11:05.35).
