PAC Swimming & Diving 2009-10 - Week 11 Conference Notes

FINAL LAP: Bethany's men's swim team celebrated Senior Day in a big way with a dual win over Urbana ... Not only was it the squad's first win of the season, but it was also the first dual meet victory by Bison men since 2006 ... The conference had a great week of competition, as PAC schools won 12 of 14 times in competition last week ... Week 12 of the season pits the top PAC seeds head-to-head, as Westminster hosts Grove City. NEWS & NOTES: Westminster broke a total of 8 pool records at SVC's Resnick Pool on Saturday, as well as won a combined 17 events (9 men's, 8 women's) ... Westminster's Courtney Herdt was the only Titan to set two individual pool records as she won the 100 and 200 breaststrokes ... Contributors to the Bethany win included the 400M team of Nick Salvagni, Patrick McCarthy, Richard Sawyer and Vinnie Giangiulio who took first in the event.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Chatham's Selina Breiner scored in 10 of her 11 swimming events at the Vulcan Challenge hosted by California (Pa.) University ... SVC's Casey Whittaker led the way for the Bearcat men this weekend, with a pair of individual victories in butterfly events, taking first in both the 100 and 200 yard races ... Saturday, four Grove City women's swimmers all picked up two wins each as Grove City handed Wooster its first loss of the season.

Bethany Bison (M: 1-7, 0-2 PAC; W: 3-6, 0-3 PAC)

The Bethany College swimming and diving teams celebrated Senior Day in style, with the Bison men picking up their first win of the season against Ur-

bana 66-58, while the BC women also beat the Blue Knights by the score of 93-65 ... Bethany's men started off on the right foot, as the 400 Medley Relay Team of Nick Salvagni, Patrick McCarthy, Richard Sawyer and Vinnie Giangiulio won the event ... Pulling out a victory was Sawyer in 200 Fly (2:31.01), while points were also earned by the other senior captain in McCarthy, who finished third in the 50 Free (16.33) and second in the 100 Free (59.65) ... For the women, the Bison started out strong by winning the first two events ... The 400 Medley Relay team of Cynthia Richardson, Desiree Finley, Theresa Smith and Liz Rubash took first, which was followed by sophomore Sara Reass winning the 1000 Free (12:47.61) ... Reass also finished second in the 500 Free to help push the Bison to victory ... In the 50 Free, Smith led the Bison when they took three of the top four positions with a time of 28.02 ... Smith also took top honors in the 200 Fly (3:02.86) ... The 100 Free looked similar to the 50, with BC claiming three of the top four positions, paced by Rubash with a time of 57.58 ... The Bison will be in action again next Saturday when they complete their dual meet schedule by swimming at Grove City.

Grove City Wolverines (M: 10-2, 1-0 PAC; W: 12-1, 2-0 PAC)

The Grove City College men's and women's swimming and diving teams both went 3-0 in non-conference action last week ... Friday, the Grove City women swept

Penn State-Behrend and Pitt-Bradford in a double dual in the Longnecker Competition Pool ... Kate Wilt won the 50 and 500 free races for Grove City ... Saturday, Bethany Johnson, Angela Palumbo, Kaitlin Riesmeyer and Jenny Ryan all picked up two wins each as Grove City handed Wooster its first loss of the season ... At 12-1, the women's squad has tied the program's single-season win record, set last year ... The men's team is 10-2 after sweeping Behrend and Pitt-Bradford Friday ... Diver Kyle Grubbs broke the school record in 1-meter diving with 303.90 points ... He also won 3-meter diving ... Josh Kim and Eric Fairchild both picked up two wins each in swimming competition ... Saturday, Grove City topped Wooster ... Grubbs won both diving events while sophomore Ben Bowser swept the butterfly ... Lincoln Larsen swept the breaststroke and Kirk Gagliardo took the 100 and 200 free ... Grove City now has 59 straight winning seasons ... The Wolverines visit Westminster Thursday.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (M: 6-5, 1-2 PAC; W: 8-4, 2-2 PAC)

Washington & Jefferson College concluded its dual-meet schedule with a sweep of Hiram on Senior Day Saturday at the Henry Memorial Natatorium ... Senior Andrew Forish paced the men's squad with three victories ... He helped the 200 medley (1:41.35) and 200 freestyle



(1:29.90) relays to a victory and also captured the 200 freestyle (1:52.40) ... Sophomore Jonathan Weeks, last week's PAC Swimmer of the Week, won three individual events, while junior Brandon Smith captured two triumphs ... Sophomore C.J. Corcoran garnered four victories for the women's squad, including individual triumphs in the 200 freestyle (2:04.41) and 100 butterfly (1:02.89) ... She also swam on winning 200 medley (1:57.32) and 200 freestyle (1:46.06) relays ... Classmate Brittany Vogel also turned in a three-victory performance, claiming the 100 backstroke (1:02.76) and 400 IM (4:53.02), while joining Corcoran on the 200 medley relay.

Chatham Cougars (W: 7-5, 1-3 PAC)



Chatham traveled to California University of Pennsylvania (Cal U) this weekend to compete in the Vulcan Chal-

lenge, a unique combination of dual and invitational scoring ... Other competitors included Lock Haven University, Mansfield University, and hosts Cal U, all Division II competitors ... The Bald Eagles of Lock Haven won the four-team invitational with 735 points, followed by the Vulcans of Cal U with 609 points, the Cougars with 548 points, and finally the Mountaineers of Mansfield with 234 points ... In dual meet action. Chatham lost to Lock Haven by a score of 91-38 and Cal U by a score of 73-56, while defeating Mansfield 113-28 ... Highlights of the meet included a victory by Chelsea Mummert in the 50 backstroke with a final time of 28.70, as well as a 2-3 finish by Mummert and junior Carly Hicks in the 100 and 200 back and 200 free races ... Emily Price placed second in the 100 IM, third in the 200 IM and fourth in the 400 IM while teammate Selina Breiner scored in 10 of her 11 swimming events ... Her highest finishes were her third place finishes in the 100 and 200 breaststrokes ... Other contributions came from Sarah Sindler in the 200 butterfly, Lyndsay Minnich in the 100 fly as well as the 1000 freestyle, and Asthen Omstead in the 200 breaststroke.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (M: 0-7; W: 2-6)

Both Bearcat squads were in action against Westmisnter on Saturday, with the men falling 140-101 and the women losing 128-113 ... **Casey Whittaker** led the way for the Bearcat men, with a pair of individual victories in butterfly



events, taking first in both the 100 and 200 yard races ... Whittaker was also part of a pair of third-place relay squads, including the 200 Medley (with Adam Thomas, Troy Linebaugh, and Matt Snelick) and the 400 Free (with Thomas, Linebaugh, and Logan Dorminey) ... Snelick earned a second-place finish in the 100 Breaststroke, while Thomas touched second in the 200 Back and Linebaugh in the 50 Free ... In women's action, Saint Vincent was able to capture a pair of first-place finishes, beginning with the 400 Medley Relay, won by foursome of Katie Custer, Jess Kennedy, Christine Dunleavy, and Maggie Dempsey ... Kennedy also earned SVC's second victory of the day, taking first in the 50 Freestyle, while she was part of SVC's secondplace 400 Freestyle Relay squad, along with Custer, Dempsey, and Amanda Haile ... Jayna Cline turned in second-place times in the 1000 and 500 Freestyle, while the Lady Bearcats' Sarah Denning took third place in both the 100 and 200 Back ... Dunleavy took third in the 100 and 200 Breaststroke, while Custer finished third in the 100 and 200 Butterfly.

Westminster broke a total of eight pool records at Saint Vincent's Resnick Pool on Saturday as the Titan men won the dual meet 140-101 and



the Titan women won 128-113 ... Additionally, Westminster won a combined 17 events (9 men's, 8 women's) ... Courtney Herdt was the only Titan to set two individual pool records as she touched first in the 100-(1:08.70) and 200-yard (2:29.41) breaststrokes ... Caitlin Lehberger also won two events by taking the 100 backstroke (1:04.00), while her first-place time in the 100 freestyle (55.02) was a pool record ... Lehberger's exhibition time in the 500 freestyle (5:24.24) was faster than Saint Vincent's first-place finisher ... Lyndsey Vogler captured two events, the 1,000 freestyle (11:22.44) and a pool-record time in the 200 backstroke (2:17.26) ... The two other pool records for the Titan women were exhibition times from Sierra Beecher in the 400 IM (4:50.26) and the 400 freestyle relay (3:46.24) ... Mark Brooks was a part of both of the men's team pool records, by winning in the 200 backstroke (2:01.40) and helping out on the meet-best exhibition time in the 400 freestyle relay (3:18.20) ...
