KENKO NAGAI

Bethany College Junior - butterfly/breaststroke Nagoya, Japan/Asahino

Nagai went undefeated in four events last week and provisionally qualified for the NCAA Championships. After winning the 100 butterfly (:53.34) and 100 breaststroke (1:00.45) at Westminster, he touched first in the 200 butterfly (1:56.02) and 200 breaststroke (2:12.25) against Mount Union. His 200 fly time was a new school-record and bettered the "B" cut for the NCAA meet.

Westminster College Senior - breaststroke/individual medley Ashville, N.Y./Panama Central H.S.

King won five events as Westminster went 3-0, including PAC wins over Bethany and W&J. Against the Bison Tuesday, she swept the 100 breaststroke (1:09.51) and 1000 freestyle (11:18.95) while swimming a leg for the winning 200 medley relay team (1:56.70). In a trimeet win over Hiram and W&J Saturday, she won the 200 meter IM (2:37.37) while swimming a leg on the pool-record 200 meter medley relay team (2:09.35).

Also nominated was freshman **Dana Culbert** of Bethany, freshman **Ellen Magee** of Grove City, and sophomore **Abby Leslie** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC SWIMMING NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison swim teams were swept by Westminster and Mount Union last week but had several solid individual performances ... Kenko Nagai went 4-0 in his events last week, winning the 100 Butterfly and 100 Breast against Westminster and then touching first in the 200 Fly and 200 Breast against Mount Union... Nagai's time of 1:56.02 in the 200 Fly was not only a College-record but also bettered the "B" cut time for the event, provisionally qualifying him for the 2003 NCAA Championships ... Joe Kennedy swept the diving events against Mount Union and Ryan Segrist took first in the 50 Free... The women's teams were led by Dana Culbert, who went 2-0 in the 50 and 100 Frees last week...Her best times of the week in the 50 (25.74) and 100 (56.56) both came against PAC rival Westminster ... Emily Young was a double-winner in the 500 and 1,000 Frees, while Rachel Yakubik swept the diving events and Katie Raynovich claimed first in the 200 Fly.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The W&J swimming and diving teams set 10 pool records on Wednesday in sweeping Penn State-Behrend in Erie ... The women's team set seven pool records led by sophomore Erin Boyle, who picked up two records with individual victories in the 200 backstroke (2:18.97) and 1000 free-style (11:24.97) ... Her senior sister Bridget Boyle also helped set two pool records by winning the 200 butterfly (2:23.76) and leading the 400 medley relay team to victory (4:27.61) ... Juniors Vanessa Tome and Amanda Westall and sophomore Jamie Chwan were also a part of the winning relay ... Tome also won the 200 breastroke (record 2:35.11), while sophomore Abby Leslie posted the pool's best score in the 1-meter diving (232.60) ... Freshman Katie Groznik concluded the W&J women pool-record setters with a triumph in the 400 IM (5:08.56) ... On the men's side, junior Chris Shively won the 200 breastroke (2:22.62) and sophomore Andrew Pratt claimed first-place honors in the 1000 freestyle (10:22.94), both pool records ... W&J also claimed the 400 medley relay in a record-setting time of 3:47.81.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster College men's and women's swimming teams each posted perfect 3-0 dual meet records this week ... On Tuesday, Westminster opened PAC competition by sweeping Bethany ... On Saturday, the Titan and Lady Titan swimmers broke six pool records as they swept a pair of dual meets against PAC rival Washington & Jefferson College and Hiram College in a tri-meet hosted by Hiram ... Seven different Titan men captured individual events vs. Bethany ... The Lady Titans were led by the duo of senior Stefanie King and sophomore April Dollard with three wins each ... Against Hiram and W&J, senior Jim Mann led the way with a pair of individual wins in the 100 backstroke (:59.72) and 200 freestyle (2:00.03), with the former setting a new pool mark ... Junior Matt Buzard was the team's other double-winner, capturing both the 50 (:24.63) and 100 (:54.35) freestyle ... The Lady Titans were paced by junior Brittany Jardine ... Jardine captured the 200 (2:15.15), 400 (4:44.09) and 800 (9:49.05) freestyle, with the 800 time setting a new Hiram pool mark.
