PAC Swimming & Diving 2008-09 - Week 12 Conference Notes

REGULAR SEASON CONCLUDES: The 2008-09 PAC swimming & diving regular season came to a close Saturday, as all six programs concluded their dual schedules. Earlier in the week, Grove City completed an unbeaten dual record against league opponents after sweeping Westminster. The Wolverines will host the 2009 PAC Championships in Grove City on Thurs.-Sat., Feb. 12-14, 2009.

WHO'S HOT: Chatham sophomore Chelsea Mummery set new school records in the 100 (1:00.75) and 200 backstroke (2:13.74) in a 148-114 win over Notre Dame (Md.) ... Senior Megan Mier of Westminster won seven events in two meets, including setting a new pool record in the 200 backstroke (2:08.42) vs. Saint Vincent on Saturday ... Sophomore Sarah Page posted six wins for Grove City in dual victories over Westminster and Wooster.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Sara Reiss captured the 100 (1:02.87) and 200 freestyle (2:16.30) to help lead Bethany to its first dual win of the year, 93-47, over Urbana ... Sophomore Brandon Smith was a triple-winner for W&J (200 & 400 IM, 200 backstroke) in the Presidents' 78-64 victory over Hiram ... Amanda Haile of Saint Vincent captured the 100 fly and swam on the winning 200 free relay team for the Bearcats vs. Washington & Jefferson.

Bethany Bison (M: 0-9, 0-3 PAC; W: 1-9, 0-4 PAC)

Bethany completed their dual meet schedule for the year against Urbana Saturday, with the women winning 93-47 and the men suffering a narrow 57-39

loss ... Sara Reass highlighted the win by taking first in the 200 free (2:16.30) and 100 free (1:02.87) ... Sara Atkins (100 backstroke) and Lindsay Arnold (50 free) posted individual wins while also swimming on the victorious 200 medley relay with Jillian Zewe and Desiree Finley ... Other first places were collected by Cynthia Richardson (200 IM) and Jessica Sarro (100 butterfly), while the men's team saw Spencer Connor win the 50 freestyle and Rich Sawyer touch first in the 500 freestyle ... The Bison's first meet of the week was at Frostburg State, where Finley set a new school record in the 11-dive, one-meter competition with a score of 358.25 ... Finley, along with Sarro, Reass and Kristen Zukoff won the 200-meter freestyle relay as well ... Reass (800, 400 free), Zukoff (50, 100 free) and Atkins (200 IM, 100 backstroke) all earned second places in multiple events as well ... For the men, Michael Bonaventura was second in the 100 Back ... Both Bison teams are now in preparation for the 2009 PAC Championships Feb. 12-14 at Grove City.


Chatham Cougars (W: 8-3, 1-3 PAC)

The Saint Vincent swim teams wrapped up the dual meet portion of their schedules on down notes, both falling to Washington & Jefferson and Westminster ... In the men's 116-82 loss to W&J Wednesday, Eric Clouse

finished first in the 100 butterfly (55.29), Dan Brett the 500 freestyle (5:15.28), and Matt Snelick the 100 breaststroke (1:04.59) ... Jon Okonak picked up a pair of second-place finishes, turning in a time of 22.61 seconds in the 50 free and 49.48 in the 100 free ... In Saturday's 150-103 loss at Westminster, Snelick took first in the 200 breaststroke, Brett the 500 freestyle, and Clouse the 100 butterfly ... In the Lady Bearcats' 105-68 defeat to W&J Wednesday, Amanda Haile earned first in the 100 butterfly (1:07.12), while Christine Dunleavy won the 100 breaststroke (1:12.09) ... Haile, Mandie West, Sarah Denning, and Molly Michael teamed up for the win in the 200 free relay (1:49.94) ... Saturday at Westminster, West picked up wins in the 500 freestyle (5:38.75) and 200 IM (2:34.10) ... Dunleavy was victorious in the 200 breaststroke (2:48.35), West the 500 freestyle (5:38.75), and Jess Kennedy the 100 butterfly (1:07.04) ... The Lady Bearcats' 200 free relay squad of Haile, Kennedy, Haley Krol, and Maggie Dempsey took the win with a time of 1:46.72.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (M: 8-3, 2-1 PAC; W: 13-1, 3-1 PAC)

The Washington & Jefferson men's and women's swimming programs concluded their dual-meet schedules with sweeps of Saint Vincent and Hiram last week ... The Presidents' women tied the school record for single-season, dual-meet wins with 13 ... Freshmen **Andy**



Rish and Katie Steider both won three events during the sweep of SVC ... Rish claimed the 50 (22.36) and 100 (49.62) freestyle events, while also leading the 200 medley relay (1:41.68) to an opening win ... Steider also touched first in the 50 (26.08) and 100 (56.40) freestyles after swimming a leg on the winning 200 medley relay (1:57.16) ... The victory was highlighted by freshman Bethany Haver, who set a pool record with 243.15 points during her win on the 1-meter diving board ... She was one point shy of automatically qualifying for the NCAA Division III Championships ... Freshman Brittany Vogel notched a pair of wins after touching first in the 200 IM (2:33.52) and 200-meter backstroke (2:31.98) ... The men's team was paced by sophomore Brandon Smith's victories in the 200 IM (2:20.71) and 200-meter backstroke (2:20.22).

Westminster Titans (M: 6-3, 1-2 PAC; W: 5-5, 2-2 PAC)

Both Westminster teams went 1-1 last week ... The Titan men lost to Grove City, 141-121, on Tuesday while the Titan women lost 155-139 ...



Westminster rebounded by beating Saint Vincent on Saturday ... The men won the dual meet 150-103 and the women won 126-99 ... In the loss to Grove City, junior Emily Dressler won three events as she broke her own school record in the 500-yard freestyle with a time of 5:09.80, beating her previous mark of 5:10.30 set the previous week ... Dressler also took the 200 (1:56.95) and 1,000 (10:55.23) freestyles in the meet against Grove City ... On the men's side, senior Zac Gebhardt and junior Ben Gutmann each won two individual events ... Gebhardt won the 500 (4:53.56) and 1,000 (10:04.26) freestyles, while Gutmann took the 100 (59.26) and 200 (2:10.29) breaststrokes ... Two Westminster Natatorium pool records were set Saturday in the Titans' final dual meet of the season ... Senior Megan Mier won two individual events and helped the Titan women win a relay as she broke the pool record in the 200 backstroke (2:08.42) ...
