The regular season came to a close Saturday for the Bethany swimming and diving teams with PAC defeats at Grove City ... The women's team suffered a 111-94 loss to the Wolverines, which completed BC's season with a record of 4-8-1 ... Senior **Cynthia Richardson** claimed first place in a pair of events ... She won the 100 backstroke by more than six seconds with a winning time of 1:10.36 ... Richardson was also credited with first place in the 200 backstroke by touching in a time of 2:33.81 ... Also winning an event was junior **Sarah Atkins**, who took first in the 100 breaststroke ... The men's team was defeated by Grove City 104-91 ... Bethany's top points came in the diving events ... Sophomore **Vinnie Giangiulio** took first in both, scoring 168.35 to win the one-meter competition and totaling 143.60 to take first on the three-meter board ... He just edged out freshman teammate **Zak Cofini** for wins in both events, as Cofini was the runner-up in the one-meter (157.45) and three-meter (141.30) competitions ... Now with the regular season in the books, the Bison will continue preparation for the 2011 PAC Championships/Grove City Longnecker Invitational, which will be held February 16-19.

Chatham Cougars

(W: 7-6, 2-3 PAC)



The Cougars competed against Division II Millersville this week in their final regular season meet ... Millersville earned the victory 146-110, but Chatham saw good performances from senior **Chelsea Mummert**, who earned victories in three races, **Laura Burrows**, and **Sarah Sindler** ... Mummert finished first in the 100 backstroke, 200 backstroke, and 200 IM races ... The Cougars' 200 fly relay team also finished first on Saturday, comprised of **Christina Habrahamshon**, **Annelies Layton**, **Lyndsay Minnich**, and **Carly Hicks** ... The team will return in two weeks as they compete in the Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) Championships.

Grove City Wolverines

The Grove City College swimming and diving teams closed the regular season last week with action Wednesday and Saturday ... Wednesday, the teams swept Westminster ... On the men's side, **Clay Beckner** swept the breaststroke and **Eric Fairchild** won the 200 and 500 free ... Saturday, in a win over Bethany, **Jared Bailey** (1650), **Ian Smyth** (100 back), **Drew Archibald** (100 breast), **Noah Walker** (200 fly), **Matt Armstrong** (50 free) and **Seth Brooks** (200 free) all recorded victories ... Several members of the team competed in the Pitt Quad Saturday, helping Grove City go 1-2 ... Beckner earned runner-up in both breaststrokes at Pitt while **Kirk Gagliardo** took second in the 100 free ... **Angela Palumbo** paced the women's team Wednesday night against Westminster by winning the 50, 100 and 200 free races ... **Kait Riesmeyer** swept the butterfly and **Jenny Ryan** won the 500 and 1000 ... Against Bethany Saturday, **Tiffani Douglas** won the 50 and 200 free while **Stephanie McNeill** won 1-meter diving ... Riesmeyer led the Wolverine effort at the Pitt Quad by earning second in the 200 fly ... Palumbo finished third in the 100 free ... Grove City will induct nine-time NCAA All-American **Richard Durstein** '77 and 1983 Division III diving champion **Dan Young** '83 into the College's Athletic Hall of Fame Saturday night.

Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcat swimmers wrapped up the regular season with a Saturday afternoon split against visiting Fairmont State, as the Lady Bearcats won 142-69, while the Bearcat men were defeated 157-90 ... In the women's meet, the Lady Bearcats were victorious in 10 of the day's 14 races, with the trio of **Christine Dunleavy**, **Jess Kennedy**, and **Katie Custer** playing a role in three wins for SVC ... In the 100 Breaststroke, Dunleavy shattered her own school record with a first-place time of 1:10.37, while she was also victorious in the 200 Breaststroke ... Kennedy took the 200 Butterfly and 200 Backstroke, and Custer the 100 Freestyle and 200 Freestyle ... The threesome also teamed up with **Maggie Dempsey** to win the 200 Medley Relay, with a time of 1:57.23 ... Other individual wins for SVC included **Carolyn Claybrooks** in the 1000 Free, **Kelsey Linstrum** the 500 Free, and **Mary Kate Kenna** the 200 Individual Medley ... The Bearcat men were led by **Casey Whittaker**, who picked up individual victories in the 200 Butterfly and 200 Individual Medley ... **Dan Kostovny** was a third winner on the afternoon for Saint Vincent, capturing first in the 200 Breaststroke ... Kostovny added a second place time in the 100 Breaststroke, while **Troy Linebaugh** took second in the 50 Freestyle, **Kreighton Long** the 1000 Freestyle, **Adam Thomas** the 200 Backstroke, and **Sam Cline** the 200 Individual Medley.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

(M: 7-4-1, 2-2 PAC; W: 13-0, 5-0 PAC)



The Washington & Jefferson women's swimming & diving team joined the 1993-94 and 2004-05 Presidents as the third team to finish the dual-meet season with an undefeated record in the 34-year history of the program ... The W&J women knocked off Division II Wheeling Jesuit 143-111 Saturday afternoon at the Henry Memorial Natatorium ... Juniors **C.J. Corcoran** and **Brittany Vogel** led the way with four and three victories respectively ... Corcoran began by swimming on the victorious 200 medley relay (1:53.98), and added wins in the 50 (25.37) and 100 (55.72) freestyles before helping the 200 freestyle relay to a victory (1:44.42) ... Vogel swam on the 200 medley relay and took first in the 200 backstroke (2:15.41) and 400 IM (4:45.65) ... Freshman **Isabella Diaz** won the 1650 freestyle with a pool record time of 18:45.33 ... Junior **Bethany Haver** won both diving events with 232.05 points on the one-meter board and 253.15 points on the three-meter ... Wheeling Jesuit defeated the W&J men 141-104 ... Senior **Christian Larson** took the only men's victory with a first place finish in the 50 freestyle (22.86) ... Junior **Justin Weifenbach** claimed both diving events with 221.65 points on the 1-meter board and 241.65 points at three meters ... W&J now is off for just less than two weeks in preparation for the 2011 PAC Championships at Grove City College Feb. 16-19.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men and women wrapped up their dual meet seasons two meets last week ... Both Titan teams lost at Grove City Wednesday with the men losing 151-124 and the women losing 160-130 ... The Titans then swept a home dual with Mount Union Saturday with the men winning 155-117 and the women winning 187.5-103.5 ... Junior **Mike Barringer** won the 100 butterfly (52.64), the 50 (22.34) and 100 (48.70) freestyles, and the 200 medley relay (1:37.97) vs. Mount Union ... Junior **Mark Brooks** also took three events vs. Mount Union with the 200 freestyle (1:48.08), the 200 backstroke (2:02.99) and the anchor of the 200 medley relay ... On the women's side, senior **Courtney Herdt** won the 100 and 200 breaststrokes in both meets including Westminster Natatorium pool records of 1:05.99 and 2:24.65, respectively, vs. Mount Union ... Junior **Caitlin Lehberger** captured four events vs. Mount Union including the 50 (25.23) and 200 (1:58.79) freestyles, the 200 IM (2:14.65) and as the anchor of the 200 freestyle relay (1:43.7).
