Guthoerl posted three wins for the Titans in their 139-84 PAC victory at Grove City on Tuesday. He captured both the 200 freestyle (1:47.65) and 200 breast-stroke (2:12.17), while swimming a leg for the victorious 400 medley relay team (3:38.74).

Magee captured three events for the Lady Wolverines in their 116-89 PAC loss to Westminster on Tuesday. She touched first in both the 100 freestyle (:55.18) and 200 individual medley (2:16.98), while also swimming a leg for the winning 400 medley relay team (4:11.13).

Also nominated was freshman **Dana Culbert** of Bethany, freshman **Jennifer O'Hara** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior **Brittany Jardine** of Westminster.

PAC SWIMMING NOTES

Bethany Bison

After suffering losses against W&J, the Bison swim teams closed the regular season with victories over the University of Charleston ... Kenko Nagai led the men's team against W&J, winning the 200 IM (2:04.2) and the 100 Breaststroke with an NCAA "B" cut time of 58.48 ... Joe Kennedy took first in the one- and three-meter diving events ... Dana Culbert was a double-winner against the Presidents with victories in the 50 (25.97) and 100 (57.01) Freestyle ... Emily Young (500 Freestyle) and Rachel Yakubik (Three-meter diving event) also took firsts ... The Bison men got their first win of the year against Charleston as Ben Brownlee (200 IM, 200 Medley Relay) took a pair of first places ... Nagai also touched first in the 1000 Freestyle ... Culbert (200 Free) and Young (200 IM) claimed individual wins and the 200 Medley Relay team also won as the Bethany women picked up their second win of the vear.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J concluded its dual season with a sweep of Bethany on Wednesday ... The President men defeated the Bison, 113-83, while the W&J men took a 123-80 decision from the BC women ... The W&J women had seven first-place finishers led by sophomore Abby Leslie, who claimed the 1-meter diving event with 238.60 points ... Sophomore Erin Boyle won the 100 backstroke (1:05.45), while classmate **Deidre Sandrock** touched first in the 100 breastroke (1:19.32) ... Sophomore Jessica Falvo won the 1000 freestyle in a time of 11:44.79 ... Freshmen Megan Thornburg, Katie Groznik and Jennifer O'Hara were also winners ... Senior Nemanja Kuzmanovic led six winners on the men's side with a victory in the 100 freestyle (52.70) ... Junior Noe Roybal won the 100 butterfly (1:02.37), while sophomore Andrew Pratt claimed the 1000 freestyle (10:45.32) ... Freshman Phil Capron took first-place honors in the 50 freestyle (23.74), while classmate Jacob Breymaier placed first in the 200 freestyle (1:54.06) ... Freshman Matt Socha also won the 100 backstroke (57.77).

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverine swim teams closed the dual-meet portion of the schedule with setbacks against visiting Westminster Tuesday night ... **Mike Shantz** accounted for both Wolverine victories by winning the 1- and 3-meter diving events ... On the women's side, **Ellen Magee** and **Peggy Whitbeck** each won three events ... Magee claimed the 100 free and 200 individual medley while Whitbeck won the 200 butterfly and 200 free ... Magee, Whitbeck, **Julie Pullin** and **Jacque Adlam** won the 400 medley relay for the Lady Wolverines ... At Pittsburgh Saturday, both Grove City squads were the top Division III entry at the Pittsburgh Panther Invitational ... Grove City's men earned 819 points while the Lady Wolverines garnered 1,195 points ... Grove City will host the PAC Championships Feb. 20-22.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster swim teams each closed their 2002-03 dual meet seasons Tuesday with wins at PAC rival Grove City College ... The wins allowed both Westminster swim teams to finish the dual meet regular season undefeated and in first place in PAC competition ... The Titan men posted a 139-84 win over the Wolverines, while the Lady Titans also won by a 116-89 count ... Three Titan swimmers - seniors Jim Mann and Craig Guthoerl and junior Matt Buzard - led the way against GCC with three wins apiece ... All three swam on the winning 400 medley relay team (3:38.74) ... Mann captured the 200 IM (1:58.47) and 200 backstroke (2:01.14), Guthoerl captured both the 200 freestyle (1:47.65) and 200 breaststroke (2:12.17), while Buzard won both the 50 (:21.96) and 100 freestyle (:48.84) ... For the Lady Titans, juniors Brittany Jardine and Megan Lytle led the way with a pair of victories each ... Jardine touched first in both the 500 (5:19.89) and 1000 freestyle (10:49.70) events, while Lytle captured the 50 freestyle (:25.34) while swimming on the winning 400 freestyle relay team (3:48.05).
