Bethany Bison

The Bethany women finished third at the PAC championship and 10^{th} overall at the Grove City Invitational, while the Bison men finished 10^{th} at the GCC Invitational.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The W&J women's swimming and diving team claimed the PAC Championship on Saturday afternoon in Grove City ... The W&J women placed second overall in the invitational with 708.5 points, trailing only national power Johns Hopkins by 52.5 points ... The W&J men's squad placed sixth of 11 teams in the event, finishing with 299 points ... The W&J women were led by freshman Nicole Erwin, who broke PAC and school records in winning the 3-Meter diving competition with a total of 409.90 points ... Sophomore Vanessa Tome also broke the school record in the 200 Breastroke and claimed the PAC individual title in the event. Her time of 2:32.37 set in the preliminaries shattered her own school record by just under one second ... On the men's side, sophomore Chris Shively set his second school record in as many days by placing fourth in the 200 Breastroke in a time of 2:12.15 ... His time of 2:12.03 in the preliminary round stands as a new W&J record ... Senior Mike Yee, who broke the school record in the 3-Meter diving on Thursday, finished in third place in the 3-Meter event with 324.25 points.

Grove City Wolverines

The Grove City College men's swimming and diving team had 14 championship finalists and won two gold medals en route to a third-place finish at the 11-school GCC Invitational Swimming & Diving Championships, Feb. 21-23 ... Freshman diver Greg Sies accounted for both Wolverine victories, setting a new pool and Invitational record on the three-meter board with a score of 436.35 and adding a new Invitational record in the one-meter event with 414.30 points ... Peggy Whitbeck posted three championship swims in three NCAA-qualifying times as the Lady Wolverines placed fourth out of 10 schools ... Winner of the meet's high-point award for the second straight year, Whitbeck beat the NCAA Division III automatic qualifier in the 100-yard butterfly (58.02) and 200 fly (2:06.03) after opening with an NCAA "B" cut in the 500 freestyle (5:08.89). All three times set new Invitational and PAC records. The 500 time also broke her own varsity record.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's & women's teams each competed at the three-day Grove City/PAC Invitational over the weekend ... The Titan men placed second out of 11 teams, while the Lady Titans finished third out of 10 squads ... The Titan men finished with four of the top six individual swimmers at the event ... Junior Jim Mann finished third with 53 points ... Tied for fourth place were junior Richard King and sophomore Matt Buzard with 49 points ... Junior Seth Bontrager finshed sixth with 48 points ... Mann also gualified for the NCAA Division II National Championships for the third straight year, posting an A-cut time of :52.06 in the 100 backstroke preliminaries ... The Lady Titans finished with three of the top five swimmers of the invitational. Sophomore Brittany Jardine was third with 54 points ... Senior Jaime Sell finished fourth with 53 points ... Junior Stefanie King finished tied for fifth with 52 points ... King also qualified for the NCAA Division II National Championships for the third consecutive year, winning the 100 breaststroke in an A-cut time of 1:07.03.
