Whitbeck led the Wolverines to the team championship at the Clarion Fall Classic this past weekend, as he captured the 50 freestyle (21.38) and took second in the 100 freestyle (49.02) in individual competition. He was also a member of the victorious GCC 400 freestyle relay team as well as the second-place 200 freestyle, 200 medley & 400 medley relay teams.

Sindler set three school records for the Cougars, who opened the 2007-08 season with a 112-68 dual victory over visiting Penn State-Altoona. She recorded times of 1:04.6 in the 100 butterfly, 12:09.67 in the 1000 freestyle, and 1:44.73 as a member of the 200 freestyle relay team - all school bests.

### Bethany Bison



The Bison will begin their 28<sup>th</sup> season under head coach **John McGowan** Saturday when they compete in the Pitt-Bradford Relays ... There are plenty of fresh faces at Bethany this season, including assistant coach **Erin Cunnane** and 19 new swimmers, including 11 for the women and eight for the men ... BC will be at Penn State Behrend Nov. 3 for their first dual meet and swim at home for the first time on Nov. 10 against Hiram.

### Chatham Cougars



Chatham University won its first dual meet of the season with a 112-68 victory over Penn State-Altoona ... First-year swimmer **Sarah Sindler** set new school records in the 1000 freestyle (12:09.67) and 100 butterfly (1:04.6) ... Sindler joined **Carly Hicks**, **Amy Kuuskoski** and **Tierney Geraci** in the 200 free relay which also established a new school mark with a 1:44.73 finish ... Chatham also established new school records in the 200 medley relay (**Rachael Moynahan**, **Sarah Rice**, **Chelsea Mummert**, **Amy Kuuskoski**, 2:17.39), 100 backstroke (**Courtney Crass**, 1:03.53) and 500 freestyle (**Carly Hicks**, 5:46.19).

### Grove City Wolverines



Both Grove City teams opened the 2007-08 season at Clarion University Friday and Saturday ... The men's team won the team title while the women took second to NCAA Division II power Clarion ... On the men's side, **Tim Whitbeck** won the 50 free, while **Jeremy Harbaugh** won the 500 ... **Rich Albertson** won the 200 butterfly ... Whitbeck, **Peter Larsen**, **Cam Coppelli** and **Drew Snyder** combined to win the 400 free relay ... Grove City also took second in the 200 free relay and both medley relays ... Junior **Kiersten Bower** led the Grove City women's team by winning the 200 butterfly ... Freshman **Sarah Bargery** posted runner-up finishes both breaststroke races ... Freshman **Lauren Baur** took second in the 200 fly while junior **Rebecca Smiddy** finished second in the 1650.

### Westminster Titans



Westminster opened the 2007-08 season Saturday at the Clarion Fall Classic ... The Titans only competed in one day of the two-day event, so team results are not applicable ... Three individuals and one relay team won events, while overall Westminster had nine swimmers and two relay teams place in the top three ... The individual winners on the women's side were senior **Becky Giles** capturing the 400-yard individual medley (4:54.80), and on the men's side juniors **Conor Simpson** winning the 100 butterfly (56.58) and **Zac Gebhardt** taking the 1650 freestyle (17:35.09) ... The remainder of the top-three finishers were all Titan men, including Gebhardt taking second in the 400 IM (4:42.93) ... **Brett Gerthoffer** placed in the top three in two events with third-place finishes in the 100 (50.25) and 200 (1:53.61) freestyle ... Gerthoffer also swam on the winning 200 freestyle relay team (1:30.62), while Simpson and classmate **Chris Lehberger** helped the 200 medley relay team place third (1:44.32) ... Lehberger touched second in the 100 breaststroke (1:04.56).
