The Bethany swimming and diving programs opened the 2006-07 season Saturday at the Pitt-Bradford Relays ... It's the earliest start in

school history for the program ... The Bison finished in fourth place out of five teams with combined men's and women's scores ... The top showing came from the mixed 200 medley relay team of Erin Staniech, Travis Edwards, Stephen Zinz and Brenda Maxwell earning second place with a time of 1:57.67 ... The Bison men's 300 backstroke relay of Patrick Piekarski, Michael Giovanetti, Edwards and Zinz touched third with a time of 3:25.39 ... Both Bethany teams begin dual meet competition Saturday with a home meet against Penn State-Behrend, which took first place at the Bradford Relays.

Grove City Wolverines



Grove City opened the 2006-07 season Oct. 20-21 at the twoday Clarion Invitational ... The men earned 1,068 team points to top host

Clarion (838), while the women finished fourth against three NCAA D-II foes: Clarion, Slippery Rock and Lock Haven ... On the men's side, junior Caleb Courage earned four wins, sweeping the sprints (50, 100 and 200 free events) and the 200 individual medlev ... Freshman Chip Cressman secured three wins: the 500, the 400 IM and the 1650 ... Sophomore Tim Whitbeck (50 free), senior Andrew Gilbert (100 breaststroke) and junior Nick Barker (200 fly) all posted runner-up efforts ... Three GCC women posted top-five performances ... Freshman Rachel Johnson placed third in the 200 backstroke while sophomore Whitney Fairchild finished fourth in both the 1650 and 400 IM ... Freshman Ruth Wiedeman took fifth in the 1650 ... Both Grove City teams will open their dualmeet seasons this weekend ... The men's team will face NCAA Division I Butler at Youngstown State Friday night, while the women's team hosts future PAC foe Chatham Saturday.

Westminster Titans



The Westminster College men's and women's swimming teams opened the 2006-07 season Friday with a combined second-place finish as hosts of the Westminster Relay Carnival at the Westminster Natatorium ... The Titan men placed second with 100 points, finishing

second behind Carnegie Mellon (122) in the five-team field ... The Titan women took third with 92 points, placing just behind secondplace Edinboro (94) ... Carnegie Mellon won the women's points standings among the six teams with 122 ... Carnegie Mellon (230) won the combined standings, finishing ahead of Westminster (192) ... The relay carnival featured a total of 20 men's and women's events ... The Westminster women's team won the 300 backstroke relay with a time of 3:10.14, while the Westminster men's team won the 500 freestyle crescendo relay with a time of 4:20.79 ... The Titan men also placed second in seven other events and the Titan women second in four additional races.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



The Bearcats opened the 2006 season with a pair of losses to West Virginia Wesleyan by scores of 102-69 (men) and 82-58 (women) ... Saturday's meet against West Virginia Wesleyan

was the first-ever meet held on campus at the Frank and Elizabeth Resnik Swimming Pool ... Last year, home meets were held at Greater Latrobe High School ... **Jon Okonak** set a school record in the 50-yard freestyle, winning the event in 22:49 ... The Bearcats remain at home this Saturday when the yhost Penn State-Altoona at 1 p.m.
