She swam legs of the winning 300-yard breaststroke and 400 IM relay at the Westminster Relays on Friday before capturing the 50 (25.21) and 100 (55.03) freestyles in a PAC dual meet win over Chatham on Saturday. The Titans placed third in the Westminster relays behind two NCAA Division II teams on Friday before beating Chatham, 152.5-129.5 on Saturday.

Also nominated was sophomore **Lindsay Arnold** of Bethany, junior **Chelsea Mummert** of Chatham and sophomore **Bethany Johnson** of Grove City.

PAC Swimming & Diving 2009-10 - Week 2 Conference Notes

WC TOPS CHATHAM, GCC SWEEPS: The 2009-10 PAC conference schedule got underway Saturday, as Westminster defeated Chatham 152.5-129.5 in New Wilmington ... The Titan men and women each placed third in their relay invitational on Friday, while the Cougars were fourth ... Grove City swept Allegheny in non-conference action, while Bethany was swept at Penn State-Behrend ... Saint Vincent had the week off.

NEWS & NOTES: Junior **Chelsea Mummert** of Chatham posted wins in the 100 (1:00.57) and 200 back (2:15.63) for the Cougars at Westminster Saturday ... Grove City freshman **Alex Mathews** swept the 500 and 1000 freestyle at Allegheny, while **Bethany Johnson** and **Kaitlin Riesmeyer** were both double winners for GCC ... Westminster freshman **Nathaniel Kronenwetter** won the first diving competition at Westminster after a 15-year hiatus Friday night.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Bethany was swept at Behrend, despite sophomore **Lindsay Arnold** placing first in the 100 butterfly (1:10.71) and second in the 200 freestyle (2:21.63) ... For the Bison men, freshman **Andrew Masterson** placed first in the 500 freestyle (5:44.93) at PS-B ... Saint Vincent and W&J were off last week ... The Bearcats swim a tri-match with Baldwin-Wallace at Penn State-Behrend Saturday, while W&J opens at Frostburg State Wednesday.

Bethany Bison

The Bethany men's and women's swimming and diving programs competed in their first dual meet of the season Saturday, as the women lost by a 97-78 count at Penn State Behrend and the men were defeated 86-56 ... Sophomore **Lindsay Arnold** had the strongest day for the Bison women. She took first place in the 100 Fly by touching in 1:10.71 and earned second in the 200 Free with a time of 2:21.63 ... Right behind Arnold in both events was sophomore **Jennifer Briskey**, as she took third in the 200 Free (2:30.14) and was just .04 seconds away from a runner-up showing in the 100 Fly with a final time of 1:19.28 ... Also scoring a first place for Bethany was freshman **Theresa Smith** in the 100 Free with a time of 1:02.51 ... The Bison men were led by freshman **Andrew Masterson**, who earned first place in the 500 Freestyle by coming in with a time of 5:44.93 ... Bethany will swim in their first home meet of the season next Saturday when they host Hiram at 1 p.m.

Chatham Cougars

Chatham competed in the Westminster Relay Carnival on Friday at Westminster College and finished in fourth place, behind Gannon University, Edinboro University, and Westminster ... On Saturday, the Cougars swam in a dual meet against Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) perennial powerhouse Westminster ... The hosts handed Chatham its first loss of the season, by a score of 152.5-129.5, giving the Cougars a 0-1 overall record and 0-1 in PAC standings ... In the Westminster Relay Carnival this past weekend, junior **Chelsea Mummert** led off the Medley Relay for her team, finishing at 1:01.4 ... She also split 1:01.37 on the Butterfly Relay and 1:00.53 on the Backstroke Relay ... In Saturday's dual meet at Westminster, Mummert earned first place in two individual events – 100 back and 200 back – finishing with times of 1:00.57 and 2:15.63 respectively ... She and her relay team also tied for first place in the Medley Relay, with a lead off 50 back in 28.36.

Grove City clinched the win as **Kirk Gagliardo**, **Josh Kim**, **Nate Nielsen** and **Eric Fairchild** won the 400 free relay ... Gagliardo (50 free) and Kim (200 fly) also tallied wins ... The women's team also produced a pair of double-winners in **Bethany Johnson** and **Kaitlin Riesmeyer** ... Johnson swept the diving events ... Riesmeyer won the 200 fly and the 500 ... Riesmeyer, **Jenny Ryan**, **Sarah Bargery** and **Sarah Page** opened the meet by winning the 400 medley relay ... Ryan won the 200 individual medley and Bargery touched first in the 200 breaststroke ... Grove City is off until hosting Carnegie Mellon November 14.
