
PAC Swimming & Diving 2008-09 - Week 2 Conference Notes

TITANS WIN RELAY CARNIVAL: Week two of the PAC swimming campaign saw the Westminster Titans capture the overall and men's team titles at their own Relay Carnival in New Wilmington ... The WC men finished with 124 points to top the five-team field, while Westminster also finished first in combined team standings with 204 points .. In women's action, Westminster placed third (80) and Chatham was fourth (74).

WHO'S HOT: Amy Kuuskoski was a triplewinner for Chatham in the Cougars' dual loss to Westminster, capturing the 500 & 100 freestyle events while also swimming a leg for the victorious 400 freestyle relay team ... Caleb Courage was a triple winner for Grove City (50, 100 & 200 freestyle) in a 174-125 loss at Carnegie Mellon Saturday ... For the Wolverine women, freshman Kate Wilt won the 100 breaststroke (1:10.25) in a 178-121 loss at CMU.
