senior Erin Staniech, who won the 100 Back in a time of 1:07.11 and took second in the 200 Free in 2:15.22 ... Freshman Kristen Zuckoff grabbed a pair of second place finishes in the 50 (28.75) and 100 (1:04,73) Freestyles, as did junior Brenda Maxwell in the 1.000 (12:24.33) and 500 (6:03.40) ... For the men, freshman Kenneth Drombosky scored one first place and one third place finish ... He won the 100 Free with a time of 51.59 and touched third in the 200 Free (1:56.50) ... Junior Nik Yacobi had the other top place, notching second in the 50 Free (26.00).

Freshman Stephanie McNeill made her collegiate debut by winning 1-meter diving ... Both Grove City teams will open the home schedule this Saturday against longtime rival Carnegie Mellon.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



The Bearcat men won their season opener by a narrow 126-125 margin over Penn State-Altoona on Saturday ... The team of Zack Krejdovsky, Joe Bruzda, Eric Clouse

and Jon Okonak won the 200 IM Medlev. while Clouse also took first in the 200 Fly ... Troy Linebaugh won the 50 free, while Bruzda set a new school record in the 200 back, timed in 2:09.92 ... Bruzda also won the 200 IM, while Krejdovsky captured the 500 Freestyle ... The Lady Bearcats were unable to defeat PSU-Altoona, falling 121-108 ... Amanda Haile earned first place finishes in the 100 and 200 Freestyle, while Karli Buday took top honors in the 100 and 200 Breaststroke ... Olivia Cinberg was also a two-time individual winner, capturing the 100 and 200 Fly ... The team of Cinberg, Katie Bittner, Sarah Denning and Haile also won the 400 Free Relay.

Westminster Titans



The Westminster men's and women's swimming teams competed in their first dual meet of the season at home against Allegheny on Friday ... The Titan men won, 169-84, and the Titan women lost, 144-118 ... Sophomore freestyler Brett Gerthoffer won three individual events

for the Titans, including the 50- (22.28), 100-(49.44) and 200-yard (1:48.62) freestyles ... Other multiple individual events winners included junior Chris Lehberger capturing the 200 breaststroke (2:16.34) and the 200 IM (29.24), juniors Conor Simpson taking the 100 (54.64) and 200 (2:04.68) butterfly races, and freshman Devin Gannon winning the 100 (57.79) and 200 (2:07.63) backstrokes ... Gannon, Simpson, Gerthoffer and sophomore Ben Gutmann won the 200 medley relay (1:41.79) ... Gutmann also won the 100 breaststroke (1:01.63). On the women's side, junior Megan Mier won the 100 backstroke (1:02.67) and the 200 IM (2:17.40) ... Westminster swimmers touched first in a total of 17 events (13 men, 4 women).
