The Titan men set a pair of invitational records on Friday night, setting new invitational-best marks in the 300 breaststroke relay (3:08.02) and the 400 individual medley relay ... Junior **Craig Guthoerl** led the Titan men by swimming on three winning relay teams at the event, while Lady Titan sophomore **Brittany Jardine** also swam for three winning relay teams for the women's squad.
