Maxell took first place in the 1000 Free (12:02.30), second in the 500 Free (5:49.10) and anchored the victorious 200 Free Relay (1:53.13) ... Staniech also earned a first in the 100 Back (1:10.77), shaved four seconds off her PR while taking third in the 200 Free (2:15.89) and led off for the 200 Free Relay ... Grabbing a second place finish for BC in the 100 Free (1:02.61) was Mallory Lee, who also swam the third leg on the 200 Free Relay ... The men's side was led by Stephen Zinz's first place in the 100 Fly (56.00) and his second place showing in the 200 I.M. (2:11.03), while Travis Edwards was first to the wall in the 50 Free (24.53) and third in the 100 Free (54.47)

Friday night, Grove City's men toppled NCAA Division I Butler (Ind.) at Youngstown State ... Senior Andrew Gilbert won the 100 and 200 breaststroke races while junior Caleb Courage won the 100 and 200 free ... Tim Whitbeck won the 50 while Nick Barker won the 200 fly ... Freshman Chip Cressman won the 1000 ... It is the second straight year that Grove City has defeated a Division I foe ... The Wolverines beat Canisius last year ... Junior Kaitlyn Orstein started her third season off with a bang after automatically qualifying for the NCAA Championships with "A" cut times in the 200 IM (2:05.39) and 100 breastroke (1:05.08) ... Her time in the 200 IM also set a new pool record ... Sophomores Alicia Sutton and Susanne Seward also were double winners for the W&J women ... Sutton claimed the 200 (2:01.27) and 500 (5:29.35) freestyles, while Seward captured the 50 (26.10) and 100 (57.77) free events ...
