Courage posted wins in the 100 & 200 freestyle in a 119-85 GCC win over Division I Canisius on Oct. 28. On Saturday at the Allegheny Distance Invitational, he won the 200 backstroke (2:04.96), 400 IM (4:23.83) and 500 freestyle (5:02.45) while helping the Wolverines capture the 800 freestyle relay (7:26.67).

Also nominated was junior **Brian Train** of Washington & Jefferson and junior **Ryan Trunk** of Westminster.

Bower, Alyse Brannon, Amanda Brozenic and Christie Hebda combined to win the 400 medley relay at the Westminster Relay Carnival Oct. 28 ... Grove City will host Carnegie Mellon Saturday.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents



Six different Presidents finished with a pair of victories as W&J opened the season with a sweep of Frostburg State Saturday ... Two-time national champion sophomore **Kaitlyn Orstein** led the women's squad with victories in the 200-meter IM (2:21.89) and the 400-meter freestyle (4:33.31) ... Her 200-meter IM time qualified her for the NCAA "A" Cut ...

Freshman **Alicia Sutton** also had a pair of wins as she claimed the 100 (1:02.10) and 200 (2:15.31) freestyle ... Classmate **Susanne Seward** touched first in the 50 freestyle (28.35) and the 100 butterfly (1:11.64) ... Junior **Brian Train** and freshmen **Eddie Werner** and **Ryan Sayers** all captured two wins on the men's side ... Train took first in the 200 IM (2:17.84) and the 100 backstroke (1:03.49), while Werner won the 200 freestyle (2:02.44) and the 100 backstroke (1:03.49) ... Sayers was victorious in both diving events ... The Presidents open their home schedule Wednesday when they welcome Mount Union ... Prior to the meet, W&J will dedicate its new scoreboard and timing system in honor of former swim coach and AD **Paul Reardon**.

Westminster Titans



Westminster competed at the Clarion Fall Classic and hosted the Titan Relay Invitational before opening its dual schedule at NCAA D-II Ashland Saturday ... The Titan men placed second at Clarion and won the Titan relays before posting a 102-102 tie at Ashland ... At Clarion, sophomore lan Yarger captured the 200 butterfly (2:12.82), while classmate **Seth Senior** touched first in the

1650 freestyle (18:24.16) ... Junior **Pat Smith** swam on three winning teams (300 back, 400 medley, 1500 free) at the Titan Relays ... Junior **Ryan Trunk** paced the Titans at Ashland, capturing both the 100 (48.18) and 200 freestyle (1:49.28) while also leading off the winning 400 medley relay (3:21.00) ... The Lady Titans placed fourth at Clarion, won the Titan Relays and fell 117-88 at Ashland ... The top Lady Titan finisher at Clarion was sophomore **Becky Giles** in second in the 400 IM (4:53.34) ... Freshman **Megan Mier** swam on both winning Titan relays: the 300 backstroke (3:13.20) and the 400 IM (4:25.77) ... Giles, Mier and sophomore **Steph Peters** posted wins at Ashland ...
