Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J opened the 2002-2003 season with a split at Gannon ... The women's squad picked up a victory behind two wins each from sophomore Jennifer Fleagle and Abby Leslie and freshman Megan Thornburg ... Fleagle won the 500 (5:33.86) and 1000 (11:15.86) freestyle events, while Leslie claimed victories in the 50 freestyle (26.85) and the 1-meter diving event with 211.25 points ... Thornburg also won the 200 freestyle (2:02.74) and the 100 butterfly (1:01.30) ... The men's team was led by junior Chris Shively and sophomore Andrew Pratt in the loss ... Shively got first-place honors in the 100 breaststroke (1:01.50), while Pratt won the 1000 freestyle (10:31.16) ... Thornburg once again paced the W&J women on Saturday, as she won the 100 butterfly by three full seconds in 1:02.24 and helped the 200 medley relay team set a pool record with a time of 1:58.22... She also claimed the 200 freestyle (2:03.62) ... Leslie claimed two individual victories for the second-straight meet, winning the 50 freestyle (26.52) as well as the 1-meter diving event (242.5) ... Pratt picked up victories in the 500 (5:01.53) and 1000 (10:27.31) freestyle events to lead the men's team.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverine swim teams opened the 2002-03 season at Carnegie Mellon on Oct. 26 ... On the women's side, junior **Peggy Whitbeck** qualified for the NCAA Championships in the 200 butterfly (2:05.72) and set a new CMU pool record in that event ... At Allegheny, Whitbeck won the 100 and 200 butterfly, 500 freestyle and 400 IM, while **Christine Bare** captured the 1650 ... Freshman **Andrew Gilbert** won the 200 breaststroke at Allegheny while **Bob Young** won the 100 and 200 backstroke races ... **Rich Korb** won the 1650 Saturday in Meadville.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's and women's swimming teams each opened the 2002-03 season on a strong note on Nov. 1 at the Natatorium in New Wilmington, as both teams captured team titles at the annual WC Relay Carnival ... The Titan men posted 140 points to top John Carroll (70), Allegheny (66), Edinboro (52), Penn State-Altoona (50) and West Virginia Wesleyan (48) ... The Lady Titans recorded 110 points to defeat West Virginia Wesleyan (90), Allegheny (80), John Carroll (70), Edinboro (52) and Penn State-Altoona (12) ... Highlighting the event for the men was the performance of the 300 yard butterfly relay team of seniors Seth Bontager and Craig Guthoerl and freshman B.J. Sieg, which set a new meet record with a time of 2:47.05, breaking the old mark of 2:47.29 set by Westminster in 2000 ... For the Lady Titans, the 400 individual medley relay team consisting of seniors Amanda Olinger, Amanda Zelechoski and Stefanie King and junior Brittany Jardine won in a time of 4:24.53, just 8/100ths of a second off the relay record of 4:24.45 set by Allegheny in 2000.
