

PAC Swimming & Diving 2008-09 - Week 3 Conference Notes

DUAL SEASON IN FULL SWING: Five of six PAC teams were in dual action Saturday ... Saint Vincent swept Penn State-Berhend, Westminster split at Allegheny and Bethany was swept by Hiram ... Chatham went 2-1 at its invitational Saturday, with the only loss coming to PAC foe Washington & Jefferson, who was a perfect 3-0 as both teams topped Division II Slippery Rock and Frostburg State in dual action ... Grove City was off Saturday.

WHO'S HOT: Emily Price of Chatham captured both the 500 and 100 freestyle events at the Chatham Invitational, while also setting a new school record in the 200 IM (2:18.84) ... Matt Snelick swept the 100 and 200 breaststroke for Saint Vincent against Behrend, while Mandie West won the 200 (2:04.51) and 500 (5:31.96) freestyle in school record times ... Westminster's Zac Gebhardt won the 500 (4:56.65) and 1000 (10:07.22) for the Titans at Allegheny.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Junior Emily Dressler won both the 500 (5:18.45) and 1000 (11:02.35) freestyle events for Westminster in a 125-80 loss at Allegheny ... Sophomore Sara Patnesky captured the three-meter diving competition for Bethany at Hiram with a score of 175.43, while also taking second place on the one-meter board (178.95) ... Four of Grove City's next five meets are at home, starting with a double dual against Chatham and Hiram Saturday.

Bethany Bison (M: 0-2, 0-0 PAC; W: 0-2, 0-0 PAC)

The Bison posted several strong performances in their meet at Hiram Saturday ... Freshman **Sara Reass** had the most highlights for the BC women.

She finished second in the 800 meter freestyle (11:08.19) and third in the 50 free (33.70) before posting the second-fastest time in the 400 free (5:25.79) ... Sophomore **Sara Patnesky** was first in the threemeter diving competition with a score 175.43 and placed second on the one-meter board (178.95) ... The other top performance was turned in by freshman **Sarah Atkins**, who had a third place effort in the 50 backstroke (37.91) ... The men's team had two second place finishes, as sophomore **Michael Bonaventura** touched second in the 50 backstroke (37.49) and senior **Nik Yacobi** was runner-up in the 50 freestyle (28.54).

Chatham Cougars (W: 5-2, 0-2 PAC)

Chatham hosted the third annual Chatham Invitational which included Washington and Jefferson College, Slip-

pery Rock University and Frostburg State University ... The Cougars earned wins over Slippery Rock and Frostburg State by scores of 204-75 and 224-45 respectively ... Chatham fell to Washington & Jefferson in the meet by a score of 152.5 – 131.5 ... Chatham got first place finishes from **Emily Price** in the 1000 and 500 yard freestyle events and by **Amy Kuuskoski** in the 200 yard freestyle ... Price also set a new Chatham record in the 200 individual medley with a time of 2:18.84 ... The Cougars travel to Grove City College this week and will look for their first PAC win of the season.

Grove City Wolverines (M: 0-1, 0-0 PAC; W: 0-1, 0-0 PAC)

Grove City's swimming and diving teams return to action Saturday, November 15 against Hiram ... The women's team will also face Chatham in the Presidents' Athletic Conference opener ... Four of Grove City's next five meets are at home, including a dual with Saint Vincent November 21.



Saint Vincent Bearcats (M: 2-1; W: 3-1)

The Bearcat men returned to winning form, defeating Penn State-Behrend 144-115 on Saturday ... **Matt Snelick** picked up a pair of individual wins, in the 100and 200 breaststroke, while **Eric Clouse** touched first in the



100 and 200 butterfly ... Clouse, Snelick, Jon Okonak, and Zack Krejdovsky teamed up to win the 200 medley relay, while Okonak picked up an individual victory in the 100 freestyle and Krejdovsky the 500 freestyle ... Dan Brett also picked up an individual win, touching first in the 1000 freestyle with a time of 11:00.78 ... The Lady Bearcats improved to 3-1 after defeating Penn State-Behrend 139-103 on Saturday ... Freshman Mandie West continued her strong start to the season, setting school records in wins in both the 200 freestyle (2:04.51) and 500 freestyle (5:31.96), while she also had a hand in SVC's win in the 200 free relay, teaming up with Haley Krol, Maggie Dempsey, and Amanda Haile ... Christine Dunleavy picked up individual wins in the 100 and 200 breaststroke, while she teamed up with Jess Kennedy, Molly Michael, and Krol to take the 200 medley relay ... Haile touched first in the 1000 freestyle, while Dempsey earned the individual win in the 50 freestyle.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (M: 1-0, 0-0 PAC; W: 4-0, 1-0 PAC)

W&J opened the 2008-09 season Wednesday with a sweep of Frostburg State ... The men were led by freshman **Michael Boutwell**, who collected two victories, including a school-record time (10:10.50) in the 1000 freestyle ... His time was three seconds faster then the



previous record set by Andrew Pratt in 2001 ... Boutwell was also victorious in the 500 freestyle (4:57.12) ... Sophomore Brandon Smith won four events, including individual wins in the 100 (56.85) and 200 (2:01.05) backstroke as well as the 200 IM (2:03.83) ... He also helped the 200 medley relay (1:40.64) to a victory ... The W&J women were paced by senior Brittany Bertoli and freshman Brittany Vogel, who both collected three individual wins ... Bertoli also led the 200 freestyle relay squad (1:46.33) to a win to total four victories on the evening ... Bertoli claimed the 200 butterfly (2:20.15), 500 freestyle (5:37.48) and 1000 freestyle (11:33.71), while Vogel earned first-place laurels in the 200 freestyle (2:01.21), 200 breaststroke (2:34.14) and 200 IM (2:15.14) ... On Saturday, W&J won the Chatham Women's Invitational ... Freshman Bethany Haver highlighted W&J's victories by winning the 3-meter diving title and also qualifying for the NCAA D-III Championships ... She posted a pool-record 258.60 points in the 3-meter event and then also set a pool record (227.96 pts.) during her win in the 1-meter event.

Westminster Titans (M: 0-0, 0-0 PAC; W: 1-0, 1-0 PAC)

The Westminster men's and women's swimming teams competed in a non-conference dual meet at Allegheny on Saturday ... The men won 131-



74 for their first dual meet win of the season while the women lost 125-80 ... Senior **Zac Gebhardt** touched first in the 1,000 (10:07.22) and 500 (4:56.65) yard freestyles ... Also winning multiple events for the men was senior **Conor Simpson** capturing the 200 freestyle (1:49.75) and the 200 butterfly (2:02.64) ... Like Gebhardt, junior **Emily Dressler** also won the 1,000 (11:02.35) and 500 (5:18.45) yard freestyles for the women ... The Titans captured a combined 11 events including the Titan men winning six events.
