### **DAN MANCUSO**



claimed the 200 & 500 freestyle Wednesday vs. Mount Union (1:50.90, 5:04.02) and Saturday against Baldwin-Wallace and Ohio Wesleyan (1:51.24, 5:02.86), while also swimming legs for the winning 200 medley relay (1:43.90) Wednesday and 400 free relay (3:22.35) Saturday.

Orstein posted four NCAA B-Cuts during the week, while leading W&J to a 3-0 dual record ... She qualified provisionally for the NCAA

D-III Championships against Mount Union during her wins in the 100 (52.27) and 200 (1:54.22) freestyle, shattering the pool- and school-record marks. She also helped the 400 freestyle relay team set a pool record (3:47.55) and led the 200 medley relay (1:53.77) to start the meet ... Orstein notched B-cut times in the 200 breaststroke (2:25.52) and the 400 IM (4:35.59), touching first in the 400 IM by over 38 seconds.

Also nominated was freshman Caitlin Gregory of Bethany, sophomore Amy Kuuskowski of Chatham, and freshman Sarah Page of Grove City.

# Bethany Bison



The Bison hosted their first dual meet of the season Saturday, falling to Hiram ... Combined, the two teams brought home six first

place finishes, including two for the men and four for the women ... Freshman Kenny Drombosky scored the two firsts for the men, as he won the 100 free in 52.12 and the 100 fly in 58.84, while also swimming the third leg on the 200 medley relay (with Pat Piekarski. Tv Walters and Nik Yacobi) that posted a time of 1:55.75 and lost by less than a second ... On the women's side, junior Brenda Maxwell was a double-winner, taking first place in the 100 breast (1:20.76) and the 500 free (5:59.28) ... Other wins were earned by senior Erin Staniech in the 50 free, as her time of 26.22 was more than a second and half better than the second place finisher, and freshman Caitlin Gregory, who touched first in the 100 back (1:10.72).

# Chatham Cougars



Chatham won the Chatham Invitational swimming meet by defeating Notre Dame College (OH), Slippery Rock University and Wheeling Jesuit Uni-

versity on Saturday ... **Amy Kuuskoski** won three individual events and was part a winning relay during the Chatham Invitational swimming meet. Amy won the 50 free (25.51), 100 free (54.91), and 200 individual medley (2.19:39) and earned the Invitational most valuable swimmer honors ... **Carly Hicks** set a new school record in the 200 backstroke (2:18.27) ... The Cougars host a tri-meet with PAC rival Saint Vincent and Mount Union this Saturday.

Whitbeck edged Larsen by .01 in the 100 free ... Grove City also swept diving ... Kyle Grubbs won 1-meter while Joe Riddell took 3-meter honors ... The women's team produced four individual winners Saturday ... Freshman Sarah Page won the 50 while senior Ellen Keefer won the 200 ... Freshman Sarah Bargery claimed the 200 breaststroke and sophomore Amanda Thompson won the 200 backstroke ... Grove City visits Saint Vincent Friday night before hosting Kenyon, W&J and Case Western Reserve in a quadrangular Saturday.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats



The Bearcat men lost a close meet against Penn State-Behrend on the road, falling 131-123 on Saturday ... Eric Clouse earned a pair of first place finishes, winning the 100 (:57.24)

and 200 (2:19.09) butterfly ... Joe Bruzda was a winner in the 200 backstroke (2:09.93), then tied for first in the 200 IM (2:11.04), despite falling behind by 1.5 seconds in the first 50 yards ... In the 1000 free, SVC finished second, third and fourth, with Bruzda, Dan Brett and Adam Hodnichak, respectively ...
