Nigrelli swept all six of his events last week as W&J topped Mount Union (133-86) and swept a double

dual with Elizabethtown (61-33) and Lycoming (57-37) to improve to 4-0. In both events, he swept the 100 (top time 49.87) & 200 freestyle (top time 1:51.87) events, while swimming legs on the 400 medley relay teams.

Tim Whitbeck won the 50 in 21.17, provisionally qualifying for the NCAA Championships ... Caleb Courage won the 100 and 200 free races, while junior Joe Riddell won 1-meter diving ... On the women's side, freshman Jane Wilson won the 100 and took second in the 50 for the Wolverines ... The Grove City men will open the home portion of the 2006-07 schedule Friday night with a double-dual against Frostburg State and Saint Vincent ... It is the second home meet of the season for Grove City's women ,who hosted Chatham Nov. 4 ... Saturday, both teams will compete in a quadrangular against Case Western, W&J and host Kenyon in Gambier, Ohio.

a win in the 50 freestyle (23.93) ... Sophomore Brittany Bertoli notched a pair of wins, claiming the 200 freestyle (2:05.48) and the 200 butterfly (2:19.65), while freshman Megan Raddatz also placed first in the 200 breaststroke (2:35.36) and the 1000 freestyle (11:29.90) ... Sophomore Zach Nigrelli paced the men with wins in the 100 (50.35) and 200 freestyle (1:52.69) ... Sophomore Eddie Werner also touched first in the 200 IM (2:05.25) and 200 backstroke (2:11.23) ... Sophomore Susanne Seward earned individual victories in the 50 (26.19) and 100 (57.15) freestyles Saturday at E'town, while Orstein notched a NCAA "A" cut time in the 200 IM (2:07.73) and a "B" cut during her win in the 200 breastroke (2:23.88) ... Nigrelli again earned a pair of victories for the W&J men in the 100 (49.87) and 200 (1:51.87) freestyle, while Werner touched first in the 200 IM (2:06.02) and 200 backstroke (2:04.68).
