Werner won all six of his events last week for the 3-0 Presidents in wins over Mount Union, Lycoming and Elizabethtown. He was a triple winner in the 100 back (56.54) and 200 free (1:48.94) and the 200 medley relay (1:43.87) against Mount Union, then captured both the 100 back (56.37) and 200 free (1:49.79) in the tri-meet with Lycoming and Elizabethtown.

Also nominated was sophomore **Caleb Courage** of Grove City and freshman **Conor Simpson** of Westminster.

Both Grove City teams fell to Carnegie Mellon Saturday in a non-conference dual meet at the Grove City College Pool ... The women's team produced a trio of double-winners against CMU ... Alyse Brannon, Amanda Brozenic, Kiersten Bower and Jaclyn Bellissimo opened the meet by winning the

400 medley relay ... Bower also won the 200 fly while Bellissimo won the 100 free ... Brannon won the 200 backstroke ... Ellen Keefer finished second in the 200 free while Whitney Baur took second in the 200 IM ... On the men's side, sophomore Caleb Courage earned two victories against CMU ... He won the 100 free in 45.71, just .02 seconds off the NCAA "A" qualifying standard, then won the 200 free ... He added a second-place finish in the 200 IM ... Diver Joe Riddell won both the 1- and 3-meter competitions ... Andrew Gilbert added a second-place finish in the 200 breaststroke ... Grove City will visit Frostburg State in a non-conference dual meet Friday night ... The men's team will compete in a double-dual with Case Western and Kenyon Saturday in Cleveland.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents



The Washington & Jefferson men's and women's teams extended their win streaks to four to open the season with victories over Mount Union, Elizabethtown and Lycoming this past week ... Sophomore **Kaitlyn Orstein** continued her strong performances with five triumphs, including a NCAA "A" Cut in the 100 breastroke (1:05.34) ... Orstein also qualified for the NCAA "B" Cut in the

200 IM (2:07.70), 50 (24.41) and 500 freestyles (5:07.87) ... Senior **Katie Groznik** picked up three victories during the week as she captured first place in the 500 and 1000 freestyles Saturday and claimed the 1000 freestyle vs. Mt. Union ... Freshmen **Eddie Werner**, **Zach Nigrelli** and **Daniel Mancuso** were all triple winners for the W&J men vs. MUC... Werner helped the 200 medley relay (1:43.87) to a win in the opening race and then posted victories in the 200 freestyle (1:48.94) and 100 backstroke (56.54) ... Nigrelli took individual wins in the 50 (22.67) and 100 (49.85) and teamed with Mancuso to place first in the 200 freestyle relay (1:33.10) ... Mancuso also touched first in the 200 IM (2:03.47) and the 500 freestyle (5:01.47) ... Mancuso claimed first place in the 200 IM (2:04.53) and 500 freestyle (5:02.82) Saturday, while Werner earned victories in the 100 backstroke (56.37) and 200 freestyle (1:49.79).

Westminster Titans



Westminster posted non-conference dual match wins over visiting Allegheny College Saturday at the Natatorium ... The Titan men (1-0-1) posted a 113-84 win over the Gators, while the Lady Titans (1-1) recorded a 121-84 decision over Allegheny ... Pacing the Westminster men was freshman **Conor Simpson** with three victories, as he captured both the 200 IM (2:06.05) and 200 butterfly (2:08.46) while swimming a leg on the winning 400 medley relay ... Junior **Ryan Trunk** posted individual wins in both

the 200 (1:50.02) and 500 freestyle (5:07.95) ... Three other Titans were double winners ... Senior **Kevin Gesacion** swam on the winning 400 medley relay team with Simpson while also touching first in the 50 freestyle (22.63) ... Juniors **Pat Smith** and **Matt Kerns** each swam on the victorious 400 freestyle relay (3:34.04) while capturing the 200 backstroke (2:05.26) and 1000 freestyle (10:40.79), respectively ... The Lady Titans were paced by sophomore **Steph Peters**, who was a double winner in the 50 (26.13) and 100 freestyle (56.13) ... Junior **Megan McLaughlin** and freshman **Megan Mier** each swam on the winning 400 freestyle relay (3:52.63), with McLaughlin also winning the 500 freestyle (5:28.66) and Mier placing first in the 200 backstroke (2:16.18).
