She placed third in the 1,650 Free with a time of 20:45.40 and also posted a solid time in the 500 Free by touching in 6:01.31 ... In the diving events, sophomore Theresa Smith placed second on the one-meter board by scoring 141.60 ... The diving events are also where the BC men posted solid finishes ... In three-meter competition, freshman Zac Cofini took first place and he finished second on the one-meter board ... Chatham finished 1-1 on the day and saw victories from Mummert in the 200 yard backstroke as well as in the 200 individual medley relay ... Mummert's finish time of 2:13.14 in the backstroke set a new pool record ... Senior Kaitlyn Lucas also set a new school record for Chatham on the three meter diving with a score of 182.30.
