Westminster College Senior - butterfly/individual medley Elkhart, Ind./Concord H.S.

Bontrager captured the 200 individual medley (1:57.25) and 200 butterfly (1:59.76) in the Titans' 110-95 win over Division II Ashland on Friday. His 200 IM time broke the nine-year-old Westminster pool record held by former Titan **Drew Dugan** (1:57.44 in 1993).

Other nominees included junior **Rich Korb** of Grove City and senior **Andrew Platt** of Washington & Jefferson.

Washington & Jefferson College Sophomore - diving/freestyle New Kensington, Pa./Kiski H.S.

Leslie posted three wins to lead the W&J women to a 4-0 record with wins over Mount Union and Elizabethtown. She qualified for the NCAA Championships with a 1meter diving total of 250.15, while also winning the 50 freestyle (:26.91) against MUC and swam on the winning 400 medley relay team (4:20.23) against E-town.

Other nominees included freshman **Ellen Magee** of Grove City and senior **Stefanie King** of Westminster.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J swept a pair of dual meets from Elizabethtown and Mount Union last week ... Sophomore Abby Leslie qualified for the national championships at 1-meter diving as she totaled 250.15 points, which is five points higher than the qualifying standard ... She also claimed the 50 freestyle in a time of 26.91 ... Freshman Megan Thornburg won three individual races for the second consecutive meet, taking first place in the 100 butterfly (1:03.66), 200 IM (2:20.09) and 500 freestyle (5:35.32) events ... Junior Vanessa Tome and sophomore Jennifer Fleagle were also double winners, as Tome garnered victories in the 100 breaststroke (1:13.39) and 200 freestyle (2:06.21), while Fleagle captured first-place honors in the 100 (57.86) and 1000 (11:21.80) freestyle ... Sophomore Andrew Pratt won the 500 (5:04.84) and 1000 freestyle (10:37.74) to lead the W&J men ... Fleagle and Thornburg each recorded two individual victories in the win over E-town ... Freshman Matt Socha led the men's squad with first-place honors in the 100 (49.81) and 200 (1:50.57) freestyle events.

The Wolverine swim teams each recorded two victories Saturday in a double-dual at GCC ... Rich Korb paced the Wolverine men with victories in the 500 and 1000 while Drew McKelvy captured first in the 200 free ... McKelvy also won the 100 free against W. Va. Wesleyan, while Andrew Gilbert won the 50 free and the 200 breaststroke against WVWC ... Bob Young won the 200 backstroke in the dual with Frostburg State and also contributed a leg of the Wolverines' victorious 400 free relay effort ... Ellen Magee and Peggy Whitbeck each won a pair of events Saturday to lift the women to 2-1 ... Magee won the 100 free and 200 medley while Whitbeck took first in the 200 free and 200 butterfly ... Christine Bare (500 free) and Annie Lindsay (200 backstroke) also notched wins ... Bare took the 1000 against WVWC while Jacquie Adlam prevailed in the 200 breaststroke against Frostburg ... Bare, Magee, Whitbeck and Carolyn Shaddak posted a victory for the Lady Wolverines in the 400 free relay.

### Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's and women's swimming teams each opened the 2002-03 dual meet season with wins Friday at the Westminster Natatorium, as the Titans and Lady Titans swept NCAA Division II Ashland University ... The Titan men won 110-95, while the Lady Titans were also victorious 106-98 ... For the Titan men, leading the way was senior Seth Bontrager, who captured both the 200 individual medley (1:57.25) and 200 butterfly (1:59.76) ... His time in the 200 IM set a new Westminster pool record, breaking the old mark of 1:57.44 set by Drew Dugan in 1993 ... Junior Matt Buzard was also a double-winner for Westminster, capturing the 50 & 100 freestyle events ... Three Lady Titans - senior Stefanie King, and juniors Megan Lytle and Brittany Jardine - each captured individual races and teamed with sophomore April Dollard to capture the 400 medley relay ... King won the 200 breaststroke, while Lytle was victorious in the 50 freestyle and Jardine finished first in the 200 butterfly
