Western Reserve Saturday. In the quad, he won the 50 (20.93), and 100 freestyle (47.66), while clinching the team wins as a member of the victorious 200 free relay (1:26.98). Against SVC, he won the 50 (20.89) and swam a leg for the victorious 400 medley relay (3:41.54).

Tim Whitbeck won the 50 and 100 free races at the Quad Meet ... On the women's side, freshman Stephanie McNeill won 1-meter diving at the Grove City Quad ... She also took second on the 3-meter board ... Freshman Sarah Page took second in the 100 free while Sarah Bargery finished second in the 200 breaststroke ... Friday night, freshman Lauren Baur won the 50 free and 100 back at Saint Vincent ... Grove City will visit Allegheny Tuesday night at 6 p.m.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



Both Saint Vincent swimming teams struggled on the week, with the men dropping two matches and the women three ... In the Grove City meet for the men, Dan Brett won the

500 freestyle (5:31.48). Eric Clouse captured the 200 breaststroke (2:34.80). Joe Bruzda touched first in the 200 backstroke (2:06.87) and 400 IM (4:36.10), and the 200 freestyle relay squad of Clouse, Kyle Kuklewski, Troy Linebaugh, and Josh Shrum won with a time of 1:37.58 ... Against Mount Union. Linebaugh won the 50 freestyle in 24:03, while Bruzda won the 200 backstroke in 2:10.58 ... For the women against GCC, Sarah Denning took the 100 freestyle in 1:01.73, Olivia Cinberg won the 200 backstroke (2:31.62) and 100 butterfly (1:04.50), and Amanda Haile took the 500 freestyle with a time of 5:48.90.



She swam the first leg and set pool and school records (23.84) ... Freshman Brandon Smith earned the only victory for the W&J men after touching first in the 200 freestyle (1:46.17) ... Freshman Angela Jones posted a first-place showing for the Presidents' women in the 3-meter diving event with 165.85 points ... Junior Susanne Seward earned first place in two individual events and also helped the 400 freestyle relay to a win in a time of 3:44.95 at Westminster ... Seward touched first in the 50 (25.79) and 100 (56.69) freestyles ... Orstein set a pair of pool records, while also breaking her own school record in the 100 butterfly (58.85).

Westminster Titans



Wednesday, Nov. 14, with the men winning, 167-90, and the women losing, 142.5-114.5 ... Against Wooster, the Titan men posted top times in four events, while the Titan women finished first in two events ... the Titan men touched first in 11 events vs. W&J with the women capturing five events ... Sophomore Brett Gerthoffer and junior Chris Lehberger each won three events during the week ... Gerthoffer won the 50 free and 100 back vs. W&J and the 200 free against Wooster, while Lehberger touched first in the 100 and 200 breast vs. W&J and the 500 free against Wooster ... On the women's side, senior Becky Giles won three events, the 400 IM in the loss to Wooster and the 200 IM and 200 breast vs. W&J.
