Shively picked up five victories as 5-0 W&J swept Mount Union, Elizabethtown and Lycoming last week. He captured the 50 freestyle and 200 breaststroke in both meets, positing times of :22.01 in the 50 free and 2:20.61 in the 200 breast against MUC. In the tri-meet on Saturday, he captured the 100 freestyle (:50.59) while posting times of :22.85 in the 50 free and 2:22.71 in the 200 breast.
