Trunk won all six of his events last week for the Titans, who posted wins over PAC foe W&J (110-95) and Wooster (117.5-81.5). He won both the 100 (47.87) and 200 freestyle (1:47.97) while anchoring the 400 medley relay team (3:40.89) against the Presidents. Versus Wooster, he captured both the 50 (21.71) and 100 freestyle (48.28) while anchoring the winning 200 medley relay (1:39.43).

Also nominated was sophomore **Joe Riddell** of Grove City and senior **Matt Socha** of Washington & Jefferson.

McLaughlin touched first in five events last week as Westminster topped conference rival W&J by one point (103-102) and defeated Wooster (118-85) for the first time ever. She had three wins against the Presidents in the 200 (1:59.38) and 500 freestyle (5:26.96) before swimming the anchor leg and touching for the .01 win in the 400 freestyle relay (3:45.93). She then won the 50 free (25.99 and swam a leg on the winning 200 medley relay (1:56.00) against the Scots.

Also nominated was senior **Jaclyn Bellissimo** of Grove City and sophomore **Kristen Mastropietro** of Washington & Jefferson.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents



Washington & Jefferson College split a pair of dual meets this week as Westminster squeaked out a pair of wins on Wednesday before the Presidents topped John Carroll on Saturday ... The women's meet at Westminster came down to the final race as the Titans earned first place by 0.01 seconds to capture the win ... Sophomore **Kaitlyn Orstein** led the W&J women after winning and

setting new school records in the 200 butterfly (2:11.56) and 200 backstroke (2:12.64), while also claiming the 200 IM in a NCAA "B" Cut qualifying time of 2:08.98 ... Sophomore **Kristen Mastropietro** and freshman **Susanne Seward** posted two wins each ... Freshmen **Daniel Mancuso** was the only double winner for the President men ... He placed first in the 200 butterfly (2:04.28) and 500 freestyle (5:03.07) ... Senior **Matt Socha** led the W&J victory at JCU on Saturday with wins in the 200 (1:51.94) and 500 freestyle (5:11.70) ... Freshmen **Eddie Werner**, **Zach Nigrelli** and **Matt Couillard** also had two victories ... Orstein set a new school record during her win in the 1000 freestyle (10:50.40) and then also took first in the 200 butterfly (2:14.95) ... Freshman **Alicia Sutton** earned first place in the 200 (2:00.98) and 500 (5:30.78) freestyles, while Mastropietro won the 200 IM (2:19.45) and 200 breastroke (2:33.48).

Westminster Titans



Westminster swimming continued to roll last week with sweeps over PAC rival W&J and Wooster ... The women's finish against the Presidents was one for the ages, as the Lady Titans trailed by eight points and needed a first and third place finish in the final event (400 freestyle relay) to win the dual meet ... Westminster (2-1, 1-0 PAC) got the victory when the Lady Titans edged W&J by .01 (3:45.93 to 3:45.94) for the top spot, followed by a third-place WC finish to clinch the 103-102 win ... On the men's side, the

Titans remained unbeaten with a 110-95 decision ... The Lady Titans were paced by junior **Megan McLaughlin**, who captured both the 200 (1:59.38) and 500 freestyle (5:26.96) before swimming the anchor leg and touching for the .01 win in the 400 freestyle relay ... Junior **Ryan Trunk** and freshman **Chris Lehberger** were both double winners for the men vs. W&J ... The Titan men remained unbeaten with a 117.5-81.5 win over the Scots Saturday, while the Lady Titans defeated Wooster for the first time in the program's history (118-85) ... Trunk captured both the 50 (21.71) and 100 freestyle (48.28) while anchoring the winning 200 medley relay (1:39.43), while freshman **Conor Simpson** added wins in both the 100 butterfly (55.80) and 200 freestyle (1:49.84) while leading off the victorious 200 freestyle relay team (1:30.66).
