Courage was a triple winner for the Wolverines at the Case Western Re-



serve Quad on Saturday, as he led the Wolverines to a 3-0 dual record with wins in the 100 free (45.36), 200 free (1:41.97) and 200 IM (school-record 1:53.73). He also swam on the winning 200 free relay team (1:24.55). Friday night, in a 160-108 dual win over PAC foe Saint Vincent, Courage swam a leg for the winning 200 medley relay (1:37.12).

Also nominated was freshman **Michael Boutwell** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior **Chris Lehberger** of Westminster.

Haver swept both the 1meter and 3-meter diving events as W&J went 4-0

last week, topping PAC rival Westminster (154-140) and going 3-0 at the CWRU Quad. She posted a score of 201.3 on the 1-meter board and adding 224.3 points on the 3-meter platform Wednesday, then led the way at Case Western Reserve. She won the 3-meter event with 269.10 points (improving her NCAA Division III Championship qualifying mark) and the 1-meter event (243.65).

Also nominated was sophomore **Sarah Page** of Grove City, and freshman **Caitlin Lehberger** of Westminster.

Mandie West took first in the 400 IM, with a time of 5:05.18, while the Lady Bearcat 400 free relay squad of Haile, Maggie Dempsey, Molly Michael, and Sarah Denning won in 3:51.89.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (M: 4-2, 1-0 PAC; W: 9-0, 2-0 PAC)

The Washington & Jefferson men's and women's swimming programs sweep over Westminster produced the 399th and 400th career victories for W&J head coach **Mike Orstein** ... Orstein now has an overall collegiate coaching record of 404-164, including a 344-139 mark



at Washington & Jefferson ... A pair of freshman led the way for the Presidents this past week, as **Michael Boutwell** broke his own school record in the 1000 freestyle with a time of 10:04:51, while diver Bethany Haver improved her NCAA Division III Championship qualifying mark on the 3-meter board with 269.10 points ... The Presidents will have two weeks off before returning to action at the James E. Longnecker Invitational hosted by Grove City College.
