Also nominated was senior **Stephen Zinz** of Bethany, freshman **Chip Cressman** of Grove City, and freshman **Luke Morgan** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC SWIMMING & DIVING NOTES

Bethany Bison



Bethany dropped close meets on both sides against Penn State-Altoona Saturday, their first action since before the Thanksgiving break

... Pacing Bethany's men's tankers was Stephen Zinz, who touched first in a trio of events, including the 200 individual medley (2:12.44), 100 butterfly (57.53) and 500 freestyle (5:28.33) ... Other first place finishes were turned in by Travis Edwards in the 200 freestyle (2:14.00). Gary Migliaccio in both diving events and the 200 freestyle relay team of Michael Giovanetti, Migliaccio, Patrick Piekarski and Edwards (1:47.29) ... For the women, Brenda Maxwell took first in two individual events and anchored the 200 freestyle relay to victory ... She won the 1000 freestyle (12:14.10) and 500 freestyle (6:02.28), while swimming the final leg for the relay that finished in 1:54.73 ... The rest of the relay included **Erin Staniech**, who also won the 100 backstrone (1:09.74), as well as Tricia Mark and Mallory Lee ... In diving, Desiree Finley scored 149.40 to win the onemeter event.

Westminster Titans



Westminster won the 10-team Wooster Invitational ... The Titans finished first in the combined teams standings with 3,547 points, including placing first in men's standings with 2,232 points and second in the women's standings with 1,315 points ... Senior All-American

freestyler Ryan Trunk posted an NCAA Division III national championship qualifying time of 45.41 in the 100 freestyle ... Trunk achieved the time in a preliminary heat before placing first in the finals in 45.84 ... The low time was also a new pool record ... Trunk also won the 50 free (20.82) and 200 free (1.43.54), while anchoring Westminster's first-place relay teams in the 400 medley relay (3:30.63), the 800 free (7:07.14) and the 400 free relay (3:09.85) ... Overall, the Titans took home 20 first-place finishes including 14 for the men and six for the women ... Junior Becky Giles won four events for the Titan women, including 2:09.21 in the 200 individual medley, which broke her own school record set last year ... Giles also won the 400 IM (4.40.07), the 200 butterfly (poolrecord 2:13.82), and swam on the winning 800 freestyle relay (pool-record 8:04.24).

Grove City Wolverines



Grove City hosted the 10th annual James E. Longnecker Invitational last weekend ... The men placed second with 999 points while the women fin-

ished fifth ... The men's team's 999 team points are the second-most in Invitational history, trailing only '06 champion Carnegie Mellon (1,081.5) ... Freshman Chip Cressman broke a 25-year-old College record in the 500 freestyle (4:44.12) ... In addition to winning the 500, he also won the 400 IM and the 1650 free ... Junior Caleb Courage swept the sprint events ... The Wolverines also won the 200 free relay, 400 free relay and 200 medley relay ... On the women's side, freshman Jane Wilson won both the 50 and 100, surpassing the NCAA "B" cut in the 50 with a College-record time of 24.32 ... Wilson, Liza McRuer, Whitney Baur and Ellen Keefer combined for a second-place finish in the 200 free relay ... Grove City earned its first-ever win over Slippery Rock in women's swimming Nov. 20, 147-111 ... The teams had never met in a dual meet before ... Grove City will open PAC action Wednesday night at Bethany ... The men's team has 499 all-time victories.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



Olivia Cinberg set a school-record by turning in a time of 1:02.31 in the butterfly, taking sixth place at the Wooster Invitational last week ... Cinberg was also part of the school-record break-

ing 200m freestyle relay, along with Erin Perry, Kristy Hartbauer, and Catherine Bittner, which finished in 14th with a time of 1:49.77 ... The 400 medley relay (Perry, Hartbauer, Cinberg, Bittner) team also entered the SVC record books with a time of 4:23.77, finishing in 12th place ... In that event, Perry led off with a school-record time of 1:07.89 in the 100 backstroke ... Both Bearcat swim teams are now off until January.

Washington & Jefferson claimed its first women's title at Grove City's James E. Longnecker Invitational last weekend ... The W&J women held a 190.5 point advantage over CMU to win the championship ...

Junior Kaitlyn Orstein opened the meet by leading the 200 freestyle team of senior Brandi Shoupe, junior Jessica Wightman and sophomore Susanne Seward to a win in 1:40.76 ... Orstein then claimed the 200 IM in an NCAA "A" cut time of 2:07.13 ... Orstein, Shoupe and Seward ended the day by teaming with sophomore Brittany Bertoli for a win in the 400 medley relay (4:07.06) ... On Saturday, Orstein set a new Invitational record during her win in the 200 breastroke (2:23.08) and led the 400 freestyle relay to victory (3:42.65) ... Freshman Alexis England posted the Presidents' next best finish after taking second in the 500 freestyle (5:29.92) ... Freshman Luke Morgan racked up the men's best showing after taking fourth in the 3-meter diving event (174.10 points) ... Freshman Megan Raddatz placed second to Orstein in the 200 breastroke (2:36.25), while Shoupe claimed third place in the 200 backstroke (2:19.42).
