Zinz was a triple-winner for the Bison last week, as Bethany opened the 2005-06 season with a 105-72 dual win over Penn State-Altoona. he touched first in the 200 freestyle (2:05.34), 100 butterfly (55.39) and 100 breaststroke (1:06.5). He captured the 200 free by over 27 seconds and the 100 fly by nearly 13 seconds.

Also nominated was sophomore **Caleb Courage** of Grove City, freshman **Daniel Mancuso** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior **Ryan Trunk** of Bethany.

Orstein posted three individual wins at the Grove City Longnecker Invitational (qualifying for the NCAA Championships in all three events) while leading four W&J relay squads to first place finishes this weekend. She posted "A" cut times in the 100 breaststroke (1:04.88) and 200 IM (2:05.91) and a "B" cut in the 400 IM (4:34.16).

Also nominated was freshman **Brenda Maxwell** of Bethany, senior **Amanda Brozenic** of Grove City, and sophomore **Becky Giles** of Westminster.

PAC SWIMMING NOTES

Bethany Bison



Bethany started the swimming season Sunday at Penn State-Altoona with a victory on the men's side, while the women were defeated ... Junior **Stephen Zinz** recorded three first place finishes, as he was first to the wall in the 200 freestyle (2:05.34), 100 butterfly (55.39) and 100 breaststroke (1:06.5) ... Seniors **Ben Brownlee** and **Noran Eyigor** also had good meets, as Brownlee won the 400 IM and 100 backstroke, while Eyigor was first in the 1000 and 100 freestyle events and swam the opening leg on the victorious 200 freestyle relay ... Despite the women's setback, senior **Dana Culbert** (50 freestyle, 100 breaststroke) and freshman **Brenda Maxwell** (500 & 1000 freestyle) took first in a pair of events ... Culbert also took second in the 100 freestyle, while sophomore **Kaitlyn Majors** earned second place in the 200 freestyle and 100 backstroke.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents



The Washington & Jefferson women notched a second-place showing, while the men's squad placed fifth this past weekend at the James E. Longnecker Invitational at Grove City ... Sophomore **Kaitlyn Orstein** continued her strong collegiate start after winning the 200 and 400 IM and the 100 breaststroke, while also leading the 200 medley and 200, 400 and 800 freestyle relays to victories ... She qualified for the NCAA "A" Cut in the 100 breaststroke and 200 IM and set a new invitational record with a NCAA "B" Cut time in the 400 IM ... Sophomore **Janna Green** recorded individual wins in the 100 and 200 backstroke events, while also swimming on the 200 medley relay ... Sophomore **Kristen Mastropietro** won the 200 breaststroke title and also swam on the 200 and 400 free relays ... Freshman **Daniel Mancuso** led the W&J men as he set a new school record during his second place finish in the 400 IM ... Freshman **Matt Couillard** missed out on a new school record by two seconds in the 1650 freestyle as he placed third ... Junior **Matt Ide** also notched fourth place in the 1-meter diving event.

Grove City Wolverines



Grove City hosted the 9th annual James E. Longnecker Invitational last weekend ... The men's team took second out of nine teams while the women claimed third in the nine-team field ... Senior **Amanda Brozenic** took third in both the 100 and 200 breaststroke while freshman **Kiersten Bower** finished second in the 100 backstroke, one spot ahead of classmate **Alyse Brannon** ... Brozenic, Brannon, Bower and **Whitney Baur** combined for a third-place finish in the 200 medley relay while the 800 free relay team of **Jaclyn Bellissimo**, **Ellen Keefer**, **Christie Hebda** and **Ellen Magee** also took third ... The men's 200 freestyle relay team set a new Grove City record (1:25.10) in winning that event ... Sophomore **Caleb Courage**, freshman **Peter Larsen**, senior **Ben Haring** and freshman **Drew Snyder** combined to win the 200 relay ... Courage won both the 50 and 100 free while **Joe Riddell** won 1-meter diving ... Junior **Andrew Gilbert** took second in the 100 breast and third in the 200 breaststroke ... **Mark Barron** earned runner-up in the 1650 ... Larsen finished third in the 200 IM ... Grove City's 400 relay set a new College record in 3:08.53 ... On Nov. 22, the Grove City men rolled to a 113-81 win over Slippery Rock ... Haring won the 100 free and 200 IM to lead the Wolverine effort.

Westminster Titans



The Westminster men's and women's swimming teams captured the combined team title this weekend at the three-day College of Wooster Invitational in Wooster, Ohio, which concluded on Saturday night ... The Titans posted a combined team score of 2,752 points to top second-place Case Western Reserve (2255) ... Westminster also captured the team title in men's competition, finishing with 1,600 points to outlast the second place Spartans (1412) ... The Lady Titans finished in fourth place with 1,152 points, narrowly trailing team champion California (Pa.) (1221.5), Wooster (1199), and Ashland (1164) ... Sophomore **Becky Giles** was the lone individual winner for Westminster, capturing the 200 backstroke (2:11.18) ... The Titan men captured the 200 freestyle relay (1:25.84), while the Lady Titans won the 800 free relay (8:06.78) ... Junior **Ryan Trunk** set a new school record in the 50 freestyle when he led off the 200 free relay in 20.93, breaking the mark of 21.02 set by Jason Kunkle in 1995 ... Trunk competed in the 100 meter freestyle Saturday at the 2005 U.S. Open Championships at Auburn University, advancing to the C-final where he finished in 24th place out of 61 swimmers in 53.19 ... Westminster hosts D-II Slippery Rock Friday before traveling to PAC rival Bethany on Saturday.
