# PAC Men's Swimmer/Diver of the Week CALEB COURAGE

#### **Grove City College**

Freshman - sprint freestyle

Courage earned PAC Swimmer of the Week honors for the second time this season after sweeping the 50, 100 & 200 freestyle events at the GCC Longnecker Invitational, setting a new school record (21.22) in the 50 free. He also swam on the second-place 200 free relay and third-place 400 medley relays teams, leading the Wolverines to a second-place finish in a nine-team field.

Also nominated was sophomore **Stephen Zinz** of Bethany, sophomore **Brian Train** Of Washington & Jefferson, and sophomore **Ryan Trunk** of Westminster.

# PAC Women's Swimmer/Diver of the Week BECKY GILES

#### **Westminster College**

Freshman - backstroke/butterfly/IM Johnstown, Pa./Westmont Hilltop H.S.

Giles broke a pair of school records while leading the Lady Titans to a second-place finish at the 11-team Wooster Invitational. She captured the 200 backstroke in 2:10.53, breaking the mark of 2:11.99 set by **Tara Crawford** in 2001. She also placed third in the 400 IM in 4:39.32, topping the program record of 4:42.66 set by **Brittany Jardine** last season.

Also nominated was junior **Dana Culbert** of Bethany, senior **Christine Bare** of Grove City, and freshman **Kristen Mastropietro** of Washington & Jefferson.

# **Bethany Bison**

The Bison men started the season with a 117-92 victory over Ohio Northern on Saturday ... Stephen Zinz and Joe Kennedy each won three events to lead the team ... Zinz finished first in the 200-yard IM in a time of 2:09.15, edging Nathan Seidner of Ohio Northern (2:10.49) ... He was also victorious in the 100-yard butterfly in a time of 56.40 and the 500-yard freestyle, which he won by almost 40 seconds in 5:32.01 ... Kennedy won the 1-meter dive (204.04) and the 3-meter dive (216.05) and was a part of the winning 200-yard freestyle relay team (1:49.97) ... The other members of the squad were Alexei Palatiello, Michael Giovanetti and Brandon Lettiere ... Dana Culbert won three events for the women, who fell by a score of 142-87 ... She was victorious in the 50-yard freestyle (26.09), the 100-yard freestyle (59.01) and the 500-yard freestyle (6:27.36) ... The other winner for Bethany was Amanda Kurta in the 100-yard butterfly in a time of 1:16.45.

# Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The W&J women's swimming and diving team placed fourth out of 10 teams, while the Presidents' men finished sixth out of nine squads this past weekend at the 8th Annual James E. Longnecker Invitational hosted by Grove City College ... Freshman Kristen Mastropietro highlighted the weekend for the Presidents as she set a new school record and earned first place in the 100 breaststroke (1:08.19) ... Mastropietro also recorded a third-place showing in the 200 breaststroke (2:32.98) ... In addition, Mastropietro teamed with seniors Erin Boyle and Kristina Springborn and sophomore Brandi Shoupe to place second in the 200 medley relay (1:52.32) ... Shoupe and Boyle joined freshmen Courtney Sheppard and Jessica Wightman for a second-place finish in the 200 freestyle (1:42.57) ... The men's team took second of nine teams while the women's team earned fifth place in the 10-team meet ... # Westminster Titans

Westminster competed at the three-day Wooster Invitational this weekend ... The Titan men finished first in an 11team field with 1,615 points, easily outdistancing Case Western Reserve (1,219), while the Lady Titans finished second with 1,387 points, trailing the host Scots (1,525) ... For the men, sophomore Ryan Trunk led the way with three first place finishes ... Trunk touched first in the 100 (46.49) and 200 freestyle (1:44.15) while also leading off for the winning Titan 400 freestyle relay team (3:11.80) ... Other Westminster men posting wins included junior Josh Hensler in the 400 IM (4:17.78) and sophomore Pat Smith in the 100 backstroke (54.91) ...
