### Men's Swimmer/Diver of the Week

#### JUSTIN WEIFENBACH Washington & Jefferson

Junior - diving Coraopolis, Pa. Montour H.S.

Weifenbach captured the 3-meter men's diving title at the Grove City Invitational with a career-best



six-dive total of 291.70, which qualified him for the NCAA D-III Championships. He also placed second in the 1-meter dive with 228.5 points.

Also nominated were Patrick McCarthy of Bethany, E.J. Leuschner of Grove City, Casey Whittaker of Saint Vincent, and Mike Barringer of Westminster.

Herdt captured both the 100 (1:05.21) and 200 breaststroke (2:19.24) at the 10-team Wooster In-

Her winning time in the 200 breast was an "A-cut" time which automatically qualified her for the NCAA D-III Championships, while both times set new invitational records. She also placed sixth in the 200 IM (2:15.05) and helped the Lady Titan 400 medley relay team place second.

#### Bethany Bison (M: 1-3, 0-1 PAC; W: 1-3-1, 0-1 PAC)

The final meet before the semester break was a good one for Bethany, as the Bison men beat Penn State-Altoona and the women defeated Ursuline and

tied with Altoona in a double dual meet ... The highlight came on the women's side, where the 200 freestyle relay of Liz Rubash, Melissa Davis, Theresa Smith and Cynthia Richardson finished in 1:47.54 to take first place and clip .39 off the previous school record ... It capped a bug day for Rubash, who also won the 200 freestyle (2:11.65) and 100 freestyle (58.34) ... Other first places for the Bison were recorded by Richardson in the 100 backstroke (1:10.26), Davis in the 100 butterfly (1:07.20) and Sara Reass in the 1000 freestyle (6:01.87) ... The men's team had a good start to their win over Altoona with the 200 medley relay team of Derrick Craddock, Patrick McCarthy, Jared Patrick and Jake Shivetts taking first place in a time of 1:53.71 ... McCarthy also won the 100 breaststroke, while Shivetts took first in the 1000 freestyle and 500 freestyle ... Bethany's other first places came from Rich Sawyer in the 100 freestyle and Vinnie Giangiulio on the one-meter diving board ... BC's depth also played a role in the win, as picking up key second place points was Patrick in the 200 IM and 100 butterfly and Andrew Masterson in the 200 freestyle and 100 backstroke.

The Cougars travel to Grove City College on Saturday, December 11th for a tri-meet against the Wolverines and Hiram College ... The meet is scheduled to begin at 1 p.m. ... The result against Grove City will count towards Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) standings while Hiram's results are non-conference.

#### Grove City Wolverines (M: 4-1, 1-0 PAC; W: 4-1, 1-0 PAC)

The Grove City College men's and women's swimming and diving squads returned to action Friday and Saturday ... Several members of each team competed in

Kenyon's Total Performance Invitational while the programs also hosted the 14th annual Winter Invitational at James E. Longnecker Pool ... Grove City's men won the Winter Invitational while the women took sixth ... At Kenyon, the men placed sixth and the women took seventh overall ... Three freshmen earned wins Saturday at the Winter Invitational: Louis Gabrielle (400 IM), E.J. Leuschner (200 free) and Dave Bossert (1650) ... Leuschner also won the 500 free Friday ... Clay Beckner provisionally qualified for the NCAA Championships in the 100 breaststroke at Kenyon with a time of 57.77 ... On the women's side, Angela Palumbo qualified for the NCAA Championships in the 50, 100 and 200 free races at Kenyon ... She set a new school record in the 50 (24.02) Friday ... Palumbo helped the 200, 400 and 800 free relays provisionally qualify also ... Kait Riesmeyer qualified for NCAAs in both butterfly events ... Jenna Richert, Sarah Page and Jenny Ryan joined Palumbo on the 200 and 400 free relay efforts ... Riesmeyer, Ryan, Richert and Palumbo comprised the 800 squad ... Grove City hosts Hiram Satur-

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats (M: 1-2, 0-1 PAC; W: 0-1, 2-1 PAC)

Both Bearcat swim teams, took part in the three-day Fredonia State Blue Devil Invitational over the weekend, with the women taking third place out of nine teams, and the men fifth ... In women's action, the team saw



three school records broken, as Jess Kennedy set a new mark with a time of 2.23.07 in the 200 backstroke, Christine Dunleavy in the 100 breaststroke in 1:11.17, and the 800 freestyle relay foursome of Carolyn Claybrooks, Amanda Haile, Kelsey Linstrum, and Mary Kate Kenna setting a new mark with a time of 8:32.77 ... Katie Custer led SVC in the 100 freestyle (third), the 50 freestyle (fourth), and 100 butterfly (sixth), while Kenna took seventh in the 400 IM and eighth in the 200 breaststroke ... In men's action, the Bearcats established a new mark in the 800 freestyle relay, as Logan Dorminey, Matt Linebaugh, Sam Cline, and Casey Whittaker teamed up for a time of 7:29.24, good for fourth place ... Whittaker also added a fourth place finish in the 100 butterfly, sixth in the 100 freestyle, and eighth in the 200 IM ... The 1650 freestyle race saw three Bearcats finish in the top 10, with Zack Krejdovsky taking third, Cline fourth, and Kreighton Long seventh ... Krejdovsky also added a seventh place finish in the 500 freestyle, while Tom Nielsen paced SVC in the 100 backstroke (seventh) and 200 backstroke (eighth).

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (M: 4-1-1, 0-1 PAC; W: 7-0, 2-0 PAC)

The Presidents men and women competed at the Grove City Winter Invitational on Saturday ... Junior **Bethany Haver** notched two diving titles on the weekend, capturing the 1-meter and 3-meter events with scores of 259.55 and 254.00 points respectively ... Her 1-



meter mark was her second NCAA Division III Championship qualifying mark this season ... On the men's side, sophomore **John Szott** was victorious on the 1-meter board with 242.90 points, while junior **Justin Weifenbach** grabbed the 3-meter men's championship with 291.70 points which qualified him for the NCAA Division III Championships for the first time in his career ... Sophomore **Katlin Dagg** placed second in the 200 butterfly (2:13.78), while junior **C.J. Corcoran** was third in the 50 freestyle (24.69) and 100 freestyle (54.05) and fifth in the 100 butterfly (1:01.04) ... Junior **Andy Rish** claimed the 200 backstroke in 2:02.30 and also placed third in the 100 backstroke (55.78) ... Junior **Jonathan Weeks** claimed second place in the 200 freestyle (1:50.91) and third in the 200 butterfly (2:04.17) and 500 freestyle (5:05.10)... Senior **Christian Larson** touched third in the 100 butterfly (56.01) and sixth in the 100 freestyle (50.13), while junior **Michael Boutwell** finished second in the 500 freestyle with a time of 5:05.08.

#### Westminster Titans (M: 3-1, 2-0 PAC; W: 3-2, 2-1 PAC)

Two Westminster swimmers automatically qualified for nationals Saturday as the Westminster competed at the Wooster Invitational Dec. 2-4



The Titan men's team placed fifth out of 10 teams with 837 points, while the Titan women's team took seventh out of 10 teams with 773.5 points ... Senior Courtney Herdt and junior Caitlin Lehberger punched their tickets to nationals as they placed first and second, respectively, in the 200-yard breaststroke with times of 2:19.24 and 2:19.31 ... Lehberger also set two new school records during the meet as she placed second in the 400 IM (4:29.59) and she led off the 200 freestyle relay with a record time in the 50 free (24.48) ... Lehberger now owns nine school records (five individual, four relays) ... Westminster posted 16 top-five finishes in individual races ... Herdt also won the 100 breaststroke (1:05.21) and Lehberger took second in the 200 IM (2:07.34) ... Junior Sierra Beecher collected three top-five finishes, including third-place times in the 200 (2:09.91) and 400 (4:37.36) IMs ... Juniors Mike Barringer and Mark Brooks and freshman Jake Scherer each posted two top-five finishes ... Barringer took third in the 100 butterfly (51.27) and the 100 freestyle (47.66) ... Brooks placed third in the 100 backstroke (53.19) and fourth in the 200 backstroke (1:58.57) ... Scherer touched third in the 1650 (16.39.82) and fourth in the 500 freestyle (4:48.85).
