Freshman - freestyle/butterfly

Zinz captured both the 1000 freestyle (11:28.77) and 100 butterfly (57.80) in a dual meet with Ohio Northern this week. He won the 1000 free by nearly 26 seconds and the 100 fly by over five full seconds.

Also nominated was senior Drew McKelvy of Grove City, freshman Brian Train of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman Ryan Trunk of Westminster.

Whitbeck won the 100 & 200 butterfly and 500 freestyle events this weekend at the Longnecker Invitational, meeting the NCAA "A" standard in both butterfly events and the "B" standard in the 500. She also swam on a record-setting 800 free relay team (8:00.66).

Also nominated was sophomore Dana Culbert of Bethany, junior Erin Boyle of Washington & Jefferson, and senior Brittany Jardine of Westminster.

PAC SWIMMING NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bethany men had six first-place finishes against Ohio Northern, led by Stephen Zinz and Joseph Kennedy, who both earned two victories ... Zinz won the 1000-yard freestyle (11:28.77) and the 100-yard butterfly, while Kennedy was victorious in the 1- and 3-meter diving events ... The women had five first-place finishes, with Dana Culbert and Rachel Yakubik both winning two events ... Culbert won the 50-yard freestyle (26.19) and the 100-yard freestyle (57.16), while Yakubik won both diving events.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Junior Erin Boyle highlighted a strong showing by the W&J women at the James E. Longnecker Invitational with two wins and a second-place finish ... Boyle won the 100 backstroke in a time of 1:01.33, which broke her own school record and also set a meet record ... She then later captured the 200 backstroke (2:15.21) in a pace just 0.24 seconds off of her own school record time from last season ... Boyle also placed second in the 200 IM (2:16.09) ... Freshman Amy Plotkin placed third in the 1650 freestyle (18:28.45), while junior Abby Leslie recorded a third-place showing in the 1-meter diving competition with 207.45 points ... Freshman Brandi Shoupe also finished third in the 50 freestyle (25.50) ... On the men's side, freshman Brian Train proved the team's best showing after winning the 200 butterfly (2:02.56) and placing fifth in the 100 butterfly (55.45) and the 200 IM (2:05.24) ... Senior Chris Shively finished fourth in the 200 breaststroke (2:19.88), while sophomore Jay Atkins touched fifth in the 50 freestyle (22.70).

Grove City Wolverines

Both Grove City squads finished third at Grove City's own James E. Longnecker Invitational last weekend ... Gannon edged Grove City's men for second by 2.5 points while the Grove City women were the top Division III squad in the meet ... Senior Peggy Whitbeck won the 500 free and both the 100 and 200 butterfly races ... Whitbeck, Christine Bare, Ellen Magee and Carolyn Shaddak set a new Invitational record in the 800 free relay with a time of 8:00.66 ... Bare (1650), Magee (100 free) and Shaddak (100 breaststroke) all had runner-up finishes individually Saturday ... Senior Drew McKelvy took second in the 200 free and third in the 100 free to help lead Grove City ... The 400 free relay team of McKelvy, John Newell, Luke Wiedeman and Matt Gibson also earned second place ... Carnegie Mellon won its third consecutive men's team title while West Virginia Wesleyan wrested the women's title from CMU.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's and women's swimming teams each placed fourth out of nine teams at the College of Wooster Invitational in Wooster, Ohio this weekend ... For the men, leading the way was freshman Ryan Trunk, who placed second in the 100 freestyle (48.19) and third in the 200 freestyle (1:47.37), while adding a sixth-place finish in the 50 freestyle ... Sophomore Josh Hensler added a third-place finish in the 400 individual medley (4:25.63) ... For the Lady Titans, senior Brittany Jardine led the way by placing third in the 200 individual medley (2:16.17) and fourth in both the 200 butterfly (2:14.12) and 400 individual medley (4:47.60) ... Other top finishers for the Westminster women included freshman Sara Bonchosky, who was third in the 100 freestyle (54.33) and fourth in the 200 freestyle (1:59.50); sophomore Megan Sweithelm, who was fourth in the 100 backstroke (1:02.78); and freshman Brittany Thomas, who finished fourth in the 1650 freestyle (18:41.70) ... The Lady Titan 200 freestyle relay team also placed second in 1:41.47 ... Westminster is off until January 10, 2004, when the Titans and Lady Titans conclude their Florida training trip at Rollins at 1 p.m.
