LINCOLN LARSEN Grove City College Sophomore - breaststroke Federal Way, Wash. Tacoma Baptist H.S.



Larsen recorded five wins (four individual, one relay) for the Wolverines last week, as Grove City defeated PAC rival

Bethany (137-46) and Hiram (151-123). He won the 200 breaststroke (2:17.41) and 200 IM (2:09.98) against the Bison, then captured the 100 (1:11.14) and 200 meter breaststroke (2:34.69) while swimming a leg on the winning 200 meter medley relay team (1:59.51) at Hiram.

Also nominated was freshman John Thiessen of Westminster.

# PAC Women's Swimmer/Diver of the Week

BECKY GILES Westminster College Senior - backstroke/IM/butterfly Johnstown, Pa./Westmont Hilltop H.S.

Giles won six events (five individual, one relay) as Westminster won PAC dual meets against Chatham (161-101) and Bethany (104-74) last week). Against



the Cougars, she touched first in the 1000 freestyle (11:27.31) and the 100 (1:01.61) and 200 butterfly (2:15.33), while also swimming a leg on the 400 free relay (3:49.94). At Bethany, she won the 100 backstroke (1:04.37) and 200 IM (2:16.23).

Also nominated was senior **Erin Staniech** of Bethany, sophomore **Amy Kuuskoski** of Chatham, freshman **Sarah Bargery** of Grove City, and junior **Brittany Bertoli** of Washington & Jefferson.

### **Bethany Bison**



Bethany was defeated in a pair of PAC meets last week, falling at Grove City and at home against Westminster ... Against GCC, Desiree

Finley earned BC's lone first place, winning the one-meter diving event (171.75) ... Caitlin Gregory was second in a pair of events (100 backstroke - 1:07.94; 200 IM-2:30.53) and Erin Staniech also took second in the 50 freestyle (26.80) ... For the men. Kenny Drombosky grabbed second place in the 200 freestyle (1:53.38) and 100 freestyle (50.89) ... Drombosky also highlighted the men's efforts against Westminster when he took third in a highly competitive race in the 100 butterfly, as he finished in 57.80, which was just .10 seconds from first place ... Brenda Maxwell scored a first for BC's women by winning the 1,000 freestyle in 12:02.42 ... Staniech took second in a pair of events, including the 50 freestyle (26.64) and 100 backstroke (1:07.88) ... Suzanne Stettinius was runner-up in the 200 freestyle (2:11.72).

day with a 151-95 home win over Bethany ... Five different swimmers posted a pair of wins against the Bison ... Double-winners Amanda Thompson, Sarah Bargery, Lauren Baur and Sarah Page also won the 200 medlev relay ... Saturday, Bargery won both breaststroke events and the 200 IM at Hiram ... Page won the 50 and 100 free ... The men's team ran its win streak to seven by downing Bethany and Hiram ... Freshman Nate Nielsen and sophomore Lincoln Larsen each notched two wins against Bethany ... Larsen then swept the breaststroke races Saturday at Hiram ... Washington & Jefferson won all 16 events and rolled to a 132-95 victory over Chatham on Tuesday at the Henry Memorial Natatorium ... Juniors Susanne Seward and Brittany Bertoli and freshman Chrissy Brant all won four events

... Seward and Bertoli teamed with senior Kaitlyn Orstein and freshman Chrissy Brant on the opening 200 medley relay which earned a victory in 1:54.00 ... Seward also earned top honors in the 50 (25.86) and 100 freestyle (56.83), while also helping the 200 freestyle relay (1:44.55) to a win ... Brant, senior Jessica Wightman and freshman Andi Wirginis joined Seward on the relay ... Bertoli grabbed three individual victories, claiming the 200 butterfly (2:18.88), 200 IM (2:22.30) and 500 freestyle (5:40.24) ... Orstein set a pool record and lowered her previous school mark in the 100 butterfly (58.76), while also touching first in the 100 breaststroke (1:05.72) ... Wirginis added first-place showings in the 200 freestyle (2:04.22) and 200 breaststroke (2:33.71) ... Brant notched wins in the 100 (1:04.54) and 200 (2:20.85) backstroke events.

### Westminster Titans



The Westminster women defeated Chatham, 161-101, at home Friday in a PAC dual meet, before both the men and the women defeated Bethany on the road by scores of 94-52 and 161-101, respectively ... Senior Becky Giles and junior Megan Mier each won six

events (five individual) during the week ... Against Chatham, Giles won the 1,000-yard freestyle (11:27.31) and the 100 (1:01.61) and 200 (2:15.33) butterfly races, while Mier finished first in the 200 IM (2:19.57) and the 100 (1:01.80) and 200 (2:13.36) backstroke races ... Both swimmers also contributed on the first-place 400 freestyle relay team (3:49.94) ... Giles also won the 100 backstroke (1:04.37) and the 200 IM (2:16.23) at Bethany, while Mier captured the 100 fly (1:02.82) and the 50 free (26.54) ... On the men's side, the Titans posted top times in all 11 events vs. Bethanv ... First-place times that counted toward the team score were John Thiessen in the 100 fly. Chris Bodle in the 200 IM, Tom Benoit in the 50 free, Devin Gannon in the 200 free and Zac Gebhardt in the 1000 free.
