PAC Men's Swimmer/Diver of the Week

GREG SIES - Grove City College

*Freshman - 1M/3M Diving
Bethel Park, PA/Bethel Park H.S.*

Sies qualified for the 2002 NCAA Division III Swimming & Diving Championships in just his fifth college meet, setting a new 11-dive pool record on the one-meter board with a score of 448.65 and posting a 280.85 in the three-meter event. Sies also set a new one-meter varsity record in the six-dive optional event at 270.80. It marked the first time in the history of the program that the one-meter, six-dive optional format was used.

Also nominated was senior freestyle specialist **Dejan Serder** of Bethany.

PAC Women's Swimmer/Diver of the Week

PEGGY WHITBECK - Grove City College

*Sophomore - Butterfly/Individual Medley
Saegertown, PA/Saegertown H.S.*

Whitbeck was a triple-winner for the Lady Wolverines in their loss to Allegheny last week, beating the NCAA provisional qualifying standard in two events. He topped the NCAA standard while winning both the 100 butterfly (:59.04) and 200 butterfly (2:11.43), and also posted a victory in the 200 individual medley (2:16.24).

Also nominated was sophomore freestyle specialist **Emily Young** of Bethany.

Bethany lost its first home meet of the year in setbacks to Hiram ... On the women's side, sophomore **Emily Young** took three first places, which included victories in the 1000 freestyle, 500 freestyle and 200 individual medley ... Senior **Tiffany Krohn** won the one-meter diving event ... For the men, no Bison took a first place ... Senior **Dejan Serder** did record a pair of second place finishes in the 50 and 100 freestyle.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City freshman **Greg Sies** qualified for the 2002 NCAA Division III Swimming & Diving Championships in just his fifth college meet, setting a new 11-dive pool record on the one-meter board with a score of 448.65 and posting a 280.85 in the three-meter event. Sies also set a new one-meter varsity record in the six-dive optional event at 270.80. It marked the first time in the history of the program that the one-meter, six-dive optional format was used ... Sophomore All-American **Peggy Whitbeck** beat the NCAA's provisional qualifying standard in two events: the 100-yard butterfly (59.04) and the 200 fly (2:11.43), while adding a win in the 200 IM (2:16.24) ... Freshman **Jacque Adlam** was a double-winner, touching first in the 100 breaststroke (1:12.27) and 200 breast (2:39.92), while sophomore **Julie Pullin** won first place in the 100 backstroke (1:04.75) ... Freshman diver **Rachel Druschel** inked her name into the GCC record book by becoming the school's first six-dive optional entry on the one-meter board, scoring a 130.60.
