The Westminster College men's and women's swimming teams collected Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) dual meet wins Saturday afternoon over visiting Bethany at the Westminster Natatorium ... The Titan men (5-2, 2-0 PAC) won 78-56 over the Bison, while the Ti-

tan women (1-6, 1-1 PAC) claimed their first victory of the season with a 75-71 win ... The wins came less than 24 hours after losing to Division II Ashland University ... The Titan men lost 161-101 while the Titan women fell 146-111 ... Junior Becky Giles was the top individual swimmer for the Titans during the two meets as she won the 200 IM against Ashland with a time of 2:10.93 ... She then won the 200 freestyle (2:04.66) and posted the best time in the 100 backstroke in the Bethany meet (1:03.69 exhibition) ...
