# PAC Men's Swimmer/Diver of the Week DREW SNYDER

### **Grove City College**

Freshman - freestyle Harmony, Pa./Seneca Valley H.S.

Snyder posted five top times in two duals as Grove City posted wins over PAC foe Bethany (88-66) and Hiram (111-84). He posted top times in the 200 (1:52.54) and 500 free (5:13.18) against the Bison. Snyder was then a triple winner against the Terriers, touching first in both the 50 meter (56.47) and 200 meter freestyle (2:03.71) as well as the 200 meter medley relay (1:57.50).

Also nominated was junior **Stephen Zinz** of Bethany and junior **Pat Smith** of Westminster.

## PAC Women's Swimmer/Diver of the Week BECKY GILES

### **Westminster College**

Sophomore - backstroke/IM/butterfly Johnstown, Pa./Westmont Hilltop H.S.

Giles touched first in five events last week as Westminster swept Division II Slippery Rock (116-87) and PAC rival Bethany (108-56). Against the Rockets, she won the the 200 breaststroke (2:35.19) and 400 IM (4:46.94). She then won three events versus the Bison: the 200 freestyle relay (1:44.91), the 100 backstroke (1:03.63) and 200 freestyle (2:04.96).

Also nominated was freshman **Brenda Maxwell** of Bethany and senior **Ellen Magee** of Grove City.

### PAC SWIMMING NOTES

### Bethany Bison



The Bison were swept in two PAC meets last week, falling at Grove City and Westminster ... The women's side had numerous good swims at Grove City, led by **Brenda Maxwell** winning the 1000 (11:39.58) and 500 (5:42.39) freestyles ... In addition, **Erin Staniech** was first

to the wall in the 100 backstroke (1:11.78) and **Dana Culbert** took second in the 50 and 100 freestyle events ... Culbert and Staniech were also the first two legs on the winning 200 medley relay, with freshman **Tricia Mark** and **Mallory Lee** swimming the final two legs ... In the Westminster meet, **Stephen Zinz** led the men's team by winning the 100 butterfly with a time of 54.91 ... For the women, Culbert had a pair of top three finishes, taking second in the 100 Free and finishing third in the 50 Free ... The Bison are now off for the next month and will return to competition Jan. 11 at Washington & Jefferson.

### **Grove City Wolverines**



Grove City opened PAC action Wednesday night by sweeping Bethany ... On the men's side, three freshmen earned wins as **Mark Barron** won the 1000, **Drew Snyder** took the 200 and **Chad Toth** captured first in the 200 IM ... Senior **Ben Haring** won the 50 ... Against Hiram Saturday, Grove City's men

improved to 5-3 by touching first in every event ... The 200 medley relay team of Joel Boerckel, Albert Cheung, Nick Barker and Drew Snyder opened the meet with a win ... Snyder also won the 200 free while Cheung won the 200 IM ... Barker won the 100 fly while Barron took first in the 800 meters ... Andrew Gilbert took the 50 while sophomore Joe Riddell won 1-meter diving ... For the women Wednesday night, Ellen Magee swept the 50 and 100 free races while Whitney Fairchild won the 200 free ... Kiersten Bower won the 200 IM and Alyse Brannon won the 100 butterfly ... Both Grove City teams are inactive until Jan. 14, 2006 when the Wolverines host Washington and Jefferson ... Grove City will also induct Scott Johnston '55, Jamie Brunk '76 and Pat Kelley '87 into its Men 's Swimming and Diving Hall of Fame that day.

#### Westminster Titans



Westminster swept D-II Slippery Rock (M/118-76, W/116-87) Friday night before both the Titans and Lady Titans remained unbeaten in the PAC with a sweep of Bethany (M/103-66, W/108-56) Saturday ... Friday vs. SRU, the Westminster women were paced by sophomore **Steph Peters**, who was a triple winner against the Rockets ... Peters touched first in both the 100 (55.86) and 200 freestyle (2:01.85), while also anchoring the victorious 200 medley relay team (1:57.58) ... Sophomore **Becky Giles** added

two individual wins in the 200 breaststroke (2:35.19) and the 400 IM (4:46.94) ... On the men's side, seven different swimmers captured individual events ... Three Titans were double winners: juniors **RyanTrunk** and **Shaun McNamara** and freshman **Nick Keagle** all swam on the victorious 200 medley relay team (1:37.86). Trunk and McNamara also swam on the 200 free relay which touched first in 1:27.76, while Keagle captured the 200 breaststroke (2:17.08) ... Junior **Pat Smith** had three wins against the Bison as he touched first in both the 200 (1:53.28) and 500 freestyle (5:07.82) while swimming a leg for the 200 freestyle relay team (1:31.65) ... The Westminster women had a pair of triple winners in junior **Megan McLaughlin** and Giles ... McLaughlin anchored both winning relays (200 medley, 1:57.42; 200 freestyle, 1:44.91) while capturing the 200 IM (2:18.69).
