PAC SWIMMING NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison men and women both went 0-2 last week, falling to PAC foes Grove City and Westminster ... The men lost to Grove City at home, 135-90, then fell at Westminster, 117-67 ... The women lost to Grove City, 120-83, and to the Titans, 115-74 ... Joe Kennedy led the Bison against GCC, as he was a part of three victories ... He won both the 1-meter and 3-meter diving events with scores of 196.15 and 175.45, respectively ... He also swam with the winning 200-yard freestyle relay team, which won in a time of 1:53.09 ... Against Westminster, sophomore Stephen Zinz was victorious in the 100-yard butterfly in a time of 54.91 and the 500-yard freestyle in 5:41.73 ... He also placed third in the 200-yard freestyle in a time of 1:55.44 ... Junior Dana Culbert led the women against Westminster by placing first in two events ... She won the 50-yard free in a time of 26.09 and later won the 100 freestyle in 56.23.

Westminster swept PAC rival Bethany and NCAA Division II Slippery Rock at the Natatorium this weewkend ... Against the Bison, sophomore Ryan Trunk led the way for the men with first place finishes in the 100 (48.47) and 200 freestyle (1:48.68) ... Seven different Westminster women captured individual events against the Bison ... Trunk captured both the 50 freestyle (22.58) and the 500 freestyle (5:01.47) against the Rock, while junior Josh Hensler won the 100 backstroke (58.43) while swimming on the 400 medley relay team (3:52.20) ... Three Lady Titans were triple-winners against SRU ... Sophomore Megan McLaughlin captured the 200 IM (2:15.79) and 500 freestyle (5:25.01) while leading off for the victorious 200 freestyle relay team (1:44.00) ... Freshman Becky Giles won both the 200 freestyle (2:02.29) and 200 butterfly (2:17.13) while swimming for the winning 400 medley relay team (3:52.20) ...
