Eaton paced the Tomcats to a second-place team finish at the Roanoke Maroon Invitational Saturday in Roanoke, Va., with top-three finishes in four events. He was second in the 200 (23.04) and third in the 400 (51.00), while running legs for the winning 4x400 relay (3:30.78) and the second-place 1,600 sprint medley relay (3:42.93).

Also nominated was junior distance runner **Josiah Leuenberger** of Grove City.

Grove City's teams opened the 2007 season Saturday at the Roanoke Invitational ... The men crowned three individual champions in **Matt Klein** (javelin), **Matt Kulinski** (pole vault) and **Josiah Leuenberger** (5000) ... Thrower

**Bob Perri** took second in the shot and third in the discus ... **Chris Allebach**, **Sam Dippold**, **Jesse Sunquist** and **Mark Murchie** took second in the 1600 relay (3:34.21) ... Kulinski and Perri (shot) both qualified for the ECAC Championships ... GCC took fourth as a team ... The women placed fifth in the 11-team field ... Sophomore **Kristen Carter** won the 5000 in an ECAC-qualifying time of 17:47.43 ... The Wolverine team of **Mary Majchrowicz**, **Joni Roberts**, **Kate Bender** and Carter won the rarely-contested 1600 medley relay.



## Thiel Tomcats

Thiel opened its season with second-place finishes at the Roanoke (Va.) Maroon Invitational ... Freshman **Alex Eaton** registered a second-place finish in the 200-meter dash (23.04), was third in the 400-meter dash (51.00) and was a member of the winning 4x400-meter relay

(3:30.78) and second-place 1,600-meter sprint medley relay (3:42.93) ... Sophomores **Alex Bue** and **Shaun Jenkins** each recorded individual titles ... Bue won the high jump (5-10 1/10 feet) while Jenkins won the triple jump (41-7 2/10 feet) ... On the women's side, sophomore **Chavonne Green** finished second in the triple jump (33-0 1/10), tied for fifth in the long jump (15-6 2/10), and was seventh in the 100-meter dash (13.72).

competed in a pair of indoor meets in February at Baldwin-Wallace and Kenyon.



## Westminster Titans

The Westminster women's team competed in its first outdoor meet of the season at the Radford University Early Bird Invitational Saturday, March 17 ... Seven Titans placed in the top eight in seven events including freshman hurdler **Abbey Basta** with two fourth-place finishes and sophomore sprinter **Kristen Van Sichel** with a pair of third-place finishes ... Basta broke a five-year-old school outdoor record with a fourth-place time of 16.1 in the 100 hurdles, which qualified her for the ECAC Championships later this season ...

She also took fourth in the 400 hurdles at 1:17.7 ... Van Sichel captured third in the 400 (1:05.0) and was the first of three consecutive Westminster finishers in the 200 with a third-place time of 28.1.
