Colley was named MVP of the Maroon Invitational at Roanoke (Va.) College Saturday after capturing both 110 meter high hurdles (14.75) and 400 meter hurdles (56.77), qualifying for the NCAA Outdoor Championships in the process. He also ran legs on the winning Thiel 4x100 meter (43.39) and 4x400 meter (3:23.39) relay teams, helping the Tomcats capture the team invitational championship.

Leading the Titan men was senior **Adam Hadbavny**, who posted fifth-place finishes in both the javelin (181-1) and shot put (47-4 1/4) ... The Lady Titans were paced by sophomore **Jessica Cooper (New Castle/Laurel H.S.)**, who finished third in the high jump (5-4 1/4) ... Senior **Sonya Cole (Youngstown, OH/Austintown**

Fitch H.S.) was the only other Top 10 finisher with a seventh-place finish in the shot put (38-9) ... Both Cooper and Cole were the top Division III finishers in their respective events.
